World Memon Organization - North India Chapter aims in helping these underprivileged families fulfil their dream of having a roof over their heads and a safe environment for the families to live in





Trustees and patrons alike, consented their unconditional support, be it moral, physical or fiscal.



WMO NIC Housing Scheme....



Neither pain nor expense was cared for while introducing the stupendous initiative an amount of more than 82000 US dollars was spent on housing projects.






Education, and a quality one for that matter, has been known to rudder many adrift vessels which would have tossed aimlessly and helplessly in the tempest of vague vision and false ambition.

NIC continues this project by supporting such children of the Memon Community. This project supports the following categories; Significantly sub average intellectual functioning: an IQ of approximately 70 or below on an individually administered IQ test (for infants, a clinical judgment of significantly sub average intellectual functioning). Mumbai based mentally challenged and Autism Memon Community deserving Children who wish to join any special school or are studying in any special schools other than above may also contact for financial assistance towards their school fees. Will also support to continue studies in other schools besides the 2 identified schools
