WMO SIC Team in Chennai instantly started COVID-19 relief work in Tamilnadu since the time lockdown was announced support was rendered by supply of essential food grains, pulses, ready to eat food to more than 5000 families in the state. Funds and ration were arranged solely by the WMO SIC RCM and our very own Memon brothers who contributed generously to support the cause.

Initially it was a daunting task to get essentials delivered to the needy, soon a plan was formulated in such a way that essentials could reach to even remote areas and small pockets of the state & City.

Route map we followed for most of the relief work was:





An **emergency Ration Kit** was compiled with the following contents:

The load of the kits were prepared and sent to various towns in Chennai, Kanchipuram & Thiruvallur districts from 10th April 2020 till date distribution is being continued Allhamdulliah.

We engaged the **area mosque president to take the responsibility** of receiving the bags and distributing it to the local needy people, hence leading to a wider reach of people.

With the help of various members of the Memon community the food grains, pulses and various essentials were arranged.













During the first week of lockdown in India, WMO SIC Chennai team served **homemade ready to eat food and juices** daily to the underprivileged in the remote areas of Chennai. A hundred packets daily were prepared and distributed.


In The Holy Month of Ramadaan WMO SIC celebrated the joy of Ramadaan with **Memon families** from the Memon colony in Chennai City.


The ration kits & financial support was arranged with the help of our fellow Memon Brothers & Sisters.









WMO SIC has extended a helping hand to our scholars by providing **essential food grains like wheat & rice and pulses** Daal and all other basic food necessities.

Further cash as Hadiyaa was provided to cover all other necessities of the masjid & madrassa.





One of the most telling human stories to result from the COVID-19 outbreak and the resulting nationwide lockdown is that of stranded migrant workers.

Labourers have been hit by both the coronavirus pandemic and the strict lockdown. Planes were sent for the rich, but the poor have to walk. But that's not the only brutality they are facing. They face the heat being daily wage earners with no food to feed their families and themselves

Such a group of migrant workers were stranded at the Chennai Central station. WMO SIC rose to the situation and immediately provided Ration 20 bags of 25 kg each of – Rice, Daal, Oil to the railway authorities to serve over 350 workers stuck at the railways.






