# KEY ACTION POINTS

- Conducted several meetings to interview and conclude on recommendations for Global Youth Wing Chairperson
- Conducted several meetings to appoint advisors to the following Chapters: US & Canada, South Africa, Middle East, Pakistan & India
- Several meetings were conducted to form the Specialist Committees and approve the written strategy papers for each
- Important meeting was held to take decisions to deal with other organisations such as – i.e. IMO, Memon Leadership Forum
- Global Ladies Wing Structure – several meetings were conducted, and a proposal paper prepared and submitted to the MC for their review and approval.
- Several meetings of the Investment Committee took place to decide the best way forward to restructure the properties in Dubai.
- Several meetings took place to prepare this years Zakaat targets and plan in coordination with all chapters
- 4 additional Trustees have agreed to register in the UK
- 1st Meeting of the International Ladies Wing conducted and meetings with individual chapters are in progress
- Guidelines for operating WMO International WhatsApp group finalized and implemented
- President has been involved in formulating the INGO status for WMO PC with the interior ministry with HM Shahzad VP for the region and also for the first time trying to collect funds in Pakistan as a registered INGO which gives tax exemptions to donors
- President has been involved re-engaging the promised lands in PC from the time of Haji ARY Saab that had been discussed with President Zardari and to ensure we get the ownership of those lands – this will happen in due course inshallah

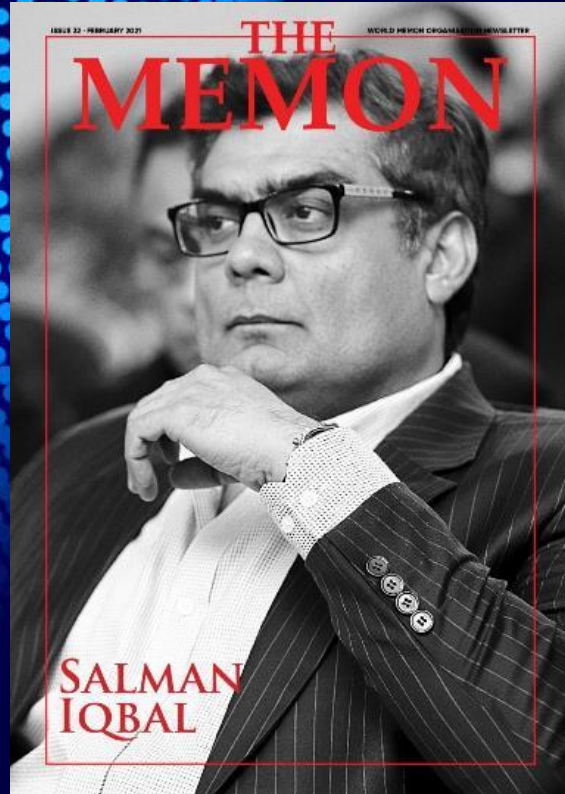
- WMO President is seeking a pardon from the Pakistan Government for our member Hussain Lawai

- President has regularly engaged with key members of MLF & IMO to invite and unify them all under the WMO banner – this is work in progress
- WMO has been pivotal in resolving the cremation issue in Sri Lanka
- Senior Office Bearers have held meetings with The British Asian Trust in partnership with HRH Prince of Wales to receive his donation for our projects in Pakistan – In Particular the project focused on “Women Empowerment”
- The President hosted an event for the Trustees and key donors in Dubai and Launched the WMO Inspire Card Project.

- Plans are in place during the holy month of Ramadhan to conduct a live telethon to raise Zakaat funds for WMO projects

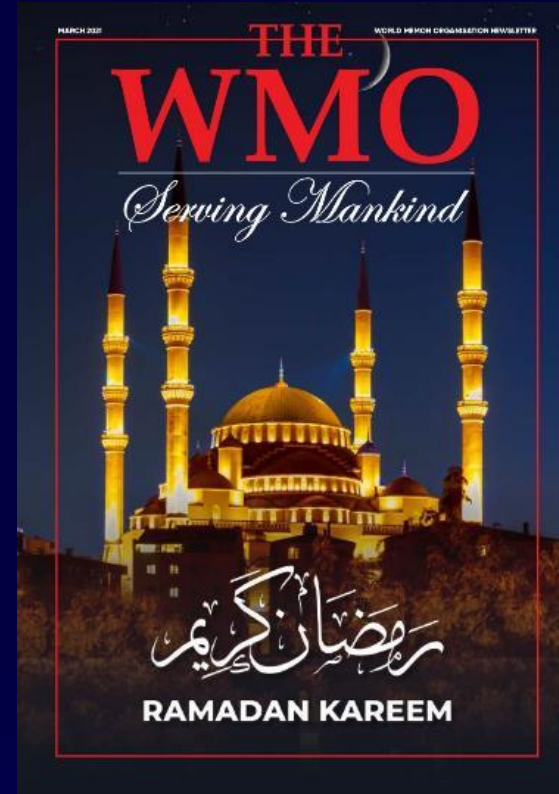





## IT IS A COLLECTIVE RESPONSIBILITY TO HELP BURY OUR DEAD

The outbreak of coronavirus is clearly a global and national emergency. Many Muslims are suffering and just from 1 week our loss from the economic impact as well as the spread of such infections and epidemics has reached an unprecedented level. 261,000 people have died since the start of the outbreak since 31st March. A total of 22,370 deaths have occurred in the UK after testing positive.

We also anticipate the number of Covid-19 related deaths to increase in the Muslim community. The death rate of Black and Asian people is much higher than that of the white population. The death rate among the Black African and Black Caribbean population in England is 1.7 times higher than that of the white population. The death rate of Black Caribbean people in London was 1.7 times higher than that of the white population.

Since the outbreak of Covid-19, the Muslim Burial Fund has helped 65 families across the UK who were unable to afford the costs associated with burying their loved ones. Without access to funds these families would have been forced to cremate. Burial costs are on average above £4,000 per person in London alone. It is a collective responsibility to help bury our dead and we will be supporting this imperative cause. **PLEASE HELP US!**

## UPDATE: **INTERNATIONAL LADIES WING**

Ms Shabana Abdul Razzak was duly appointed to the post of International Ladies Wing Chairperson on 19<sup>th</sup> December 2020 at the 1<sup>st</sup> Management Committee meeting of the new Term 2020-2023.

Ms Shabana immediately had the intention of formulating a structure for the Ladies Specialist Committee not too dissimilar to the structure now in place for the Global Youth Wing. As such, one of her first tasks was to reach out to the now newly elected Secretary General of the WMO Mr Bashir Sattar who had masterminded and founded the Global Youth Wing in 2017.

Ms Shabana also set up a consultation team to assist with this important inaugural project of her term. The team comprised of the following members of the Ladies Wing; Dr Sana Durvesh, Ms Farzana Noor, Dr Shahana Pathan, Ms Dania Hanif, Ms Shazia Sangani, Ms Rabiya Wasiq & Ms Falak Shaikhani

Ms Shabana took an objective approach to the consultation which included a SWOT analysis and several workshops all conducted by Zoom over a period of three months. In order to achieve the objectives, the guidance and assistance of Mr Bashir Sattar was requested throughout the process of consultation. A paper was drafted for the formation of the Global Ladies Wing which will be put forward for consideration at the next Management Committee meeting. The very brief highlights of the proposals are as follows:

1. The four proposed OBs of GLW i.e., Chair, Deputy Chair, Secretary and Treasurer should be part of the ExeCom and appointed members of the MC.
2. A new structure to be created similar to the one prevailing in the Global Youth Wing covering all regions. This is intended to create wider participation and ownership from women in local projects and programs
3. The new structure when implemented will also foster greater development of women both within the RMC and the global stage of the WMO
4. A new category of female membership should be introduced which will be Free of Cost.
5. The Regional team of GLW OBs will comprise of following positions:
  - a) Regional Ladies Chair
  - b) Regional Ladies Secretary
  - c) Regional Ladies Treasurer
6. Regional Ladies Chair shall be a member of Regional Management Committee (RMC) and Management Committee (MC).
7. Regional Ladies Executives in India and Pakistan to have 20 members whereas all other chapters to have 10 members.
8. State Vice Chairs shall be appointed for larger geographic regions such as USA, CANADA, and INDIA by the Regional Ladies Chair in consent with the Global Ladies Wing Chair.
