Health systems in many parts of the country are completely overwhelmed, reports of oxygen shortage are pouring in, and as cases surge, some States have imposed local lockdowns.

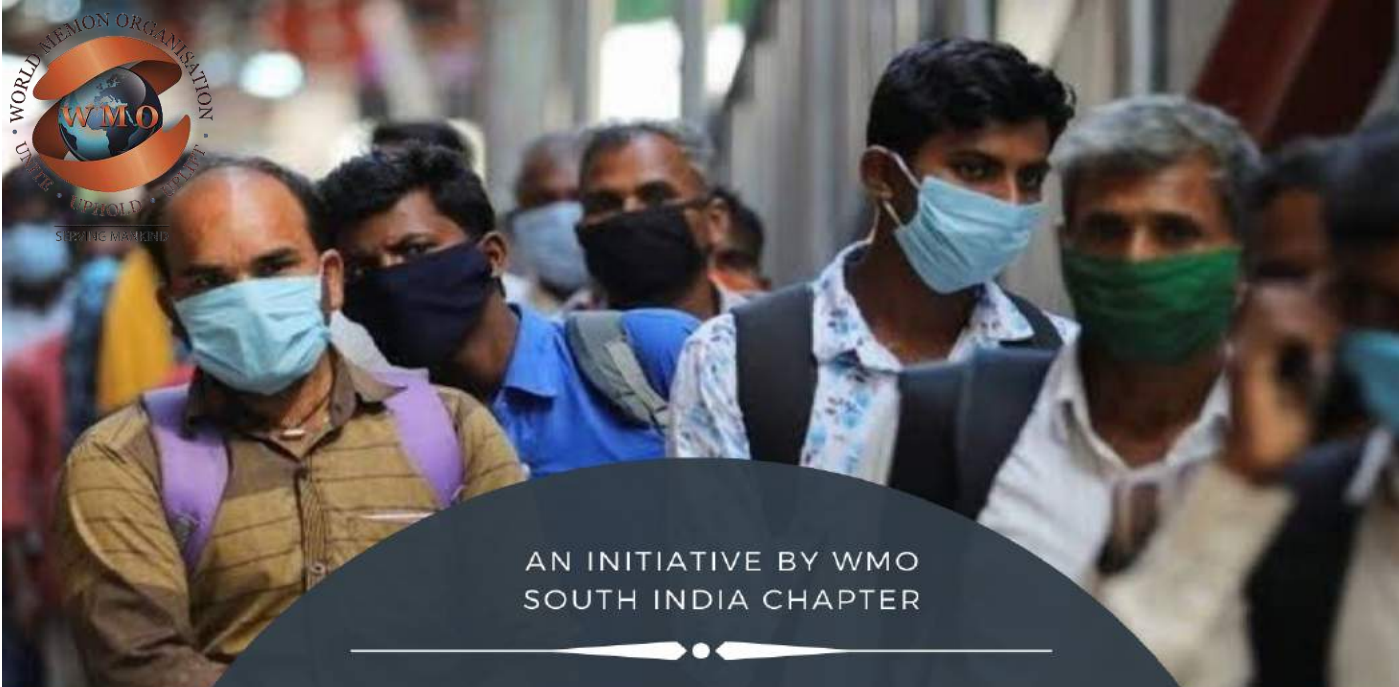
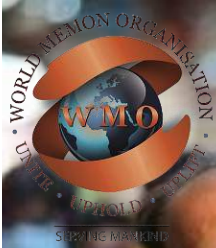
The second wave in India is stressing the system to an incredible extent and in so many ways. Patients have been unable to access care because hospitals have been overwhelmed. Outcomes in hospitals have been poor because doctors and nurses are overwhelmed and there is inadequate supply to treat these huge numbers of patients. There has been a lack of medicines, lack of equipment, lack of ventilators and even hospital beds. Finally, the most critical crisis has been the lack of oxygen.

With the **Holy month of Ramadan** approached on us in Mid-April and with the second wave of COVID-19 infections peaking by the end of April WMO South India Chapter undertook **various projects** to support the deprived in this hour of need.

With Lockdown in force no businesses functioning many had and are still facing the heat and hence we supported families financially as well as by distribution of food grains and pulses and other essential items.

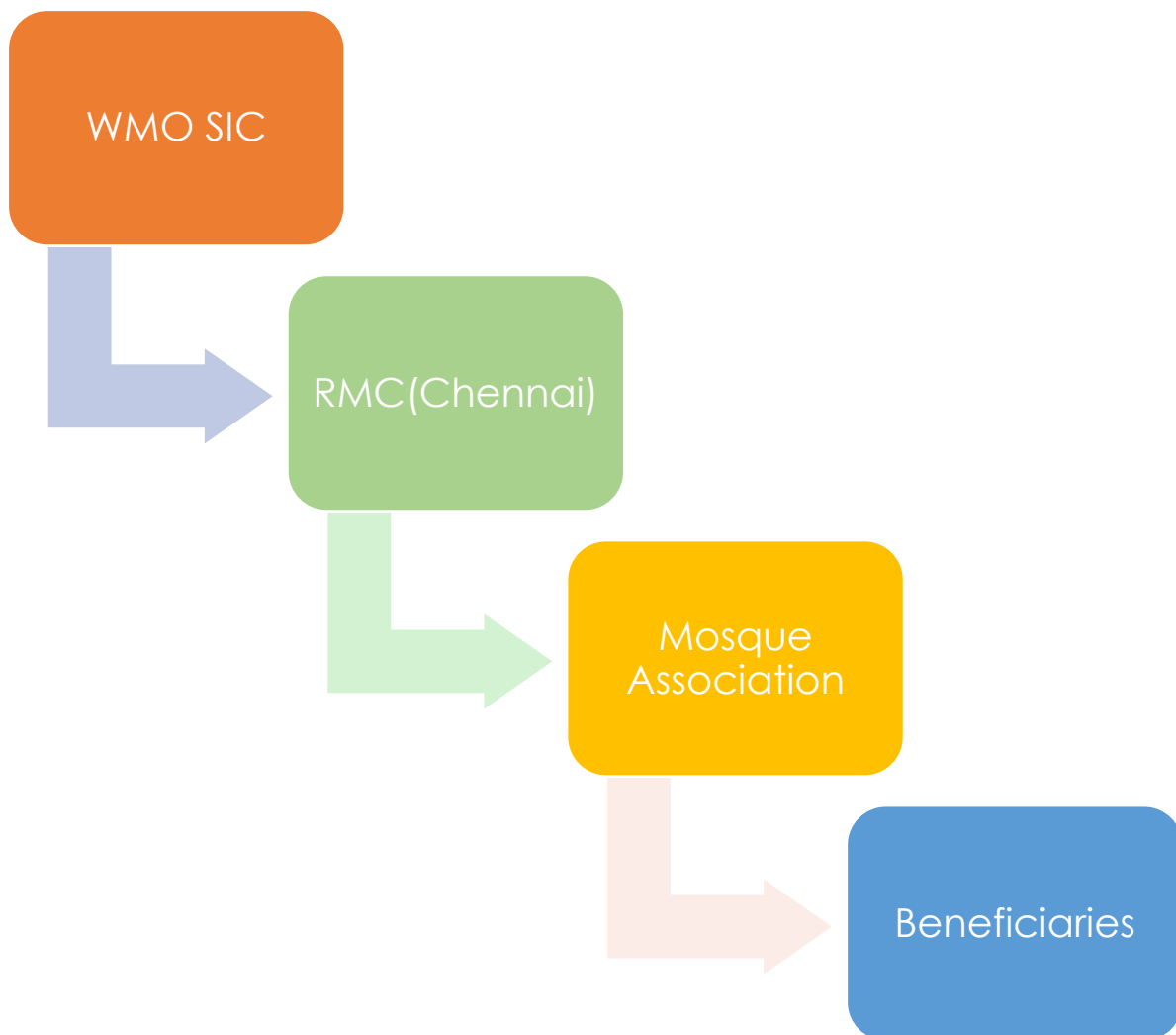


WMO SIC (CHENNAI)

WMO SIC Team in association with Hajee Ebrahim HAR trust in Chennai immediately started Ramadan Charity work along with Covid-19 Relief work in the State of Tamilnadu, support was rendered by supply of essential food grains & pulses to more than 5000 families in the state. **Funds and ration were arranged solely by the WMO SIC RMC and Hajee Ebrahim HAR Trust who contributed generously to support the cause.**

Initially it was a daunting task to get essentials delivered to the needy, soon a plan was formulated in such a way that essentials could reach to even remote areas and small pockets of the state & City.

Route map we followed for most of the relief work was:



As a part of the Rice Bag Distribution Drive conducted in March in the **Current Phase 2** we prepared Rice Bags of 5 kilos each. The load of these grains were prepared and sent to various towns in Chennai, Kanchipuram & Thiruvallur districts for the whole month 30 days of Ramadan 2021.

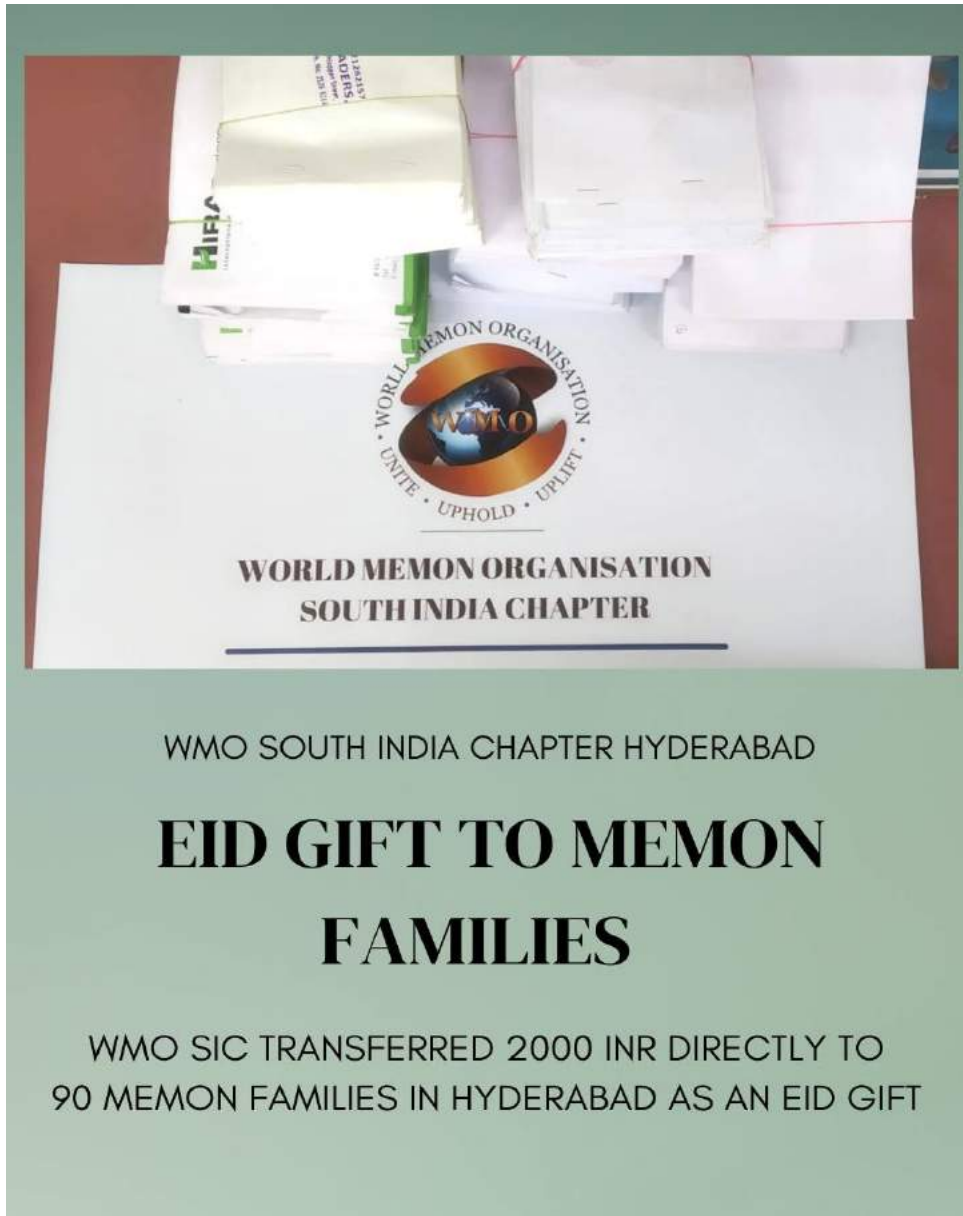
Allhamdulillah over **1800+ Rice Bags** were distributed to 280 mosques.

We engaged the **area mosque president to take the responsibility** of receiving the bags and distributing it to the local needy people, hence leading to a wider reach of people.

With the help of various members of the Local Memon community the food grains, pulses and various essentials were arranged.







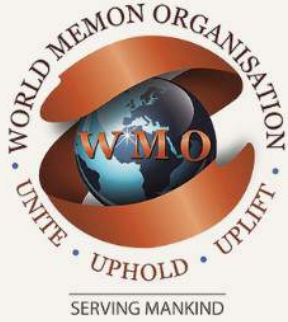
WMO SIC (HYDERABAD)

After successful implementation of Free Corona Kavach in Bangalore this scheme is now being offered in Chennai Hyderabad & Madurai too.

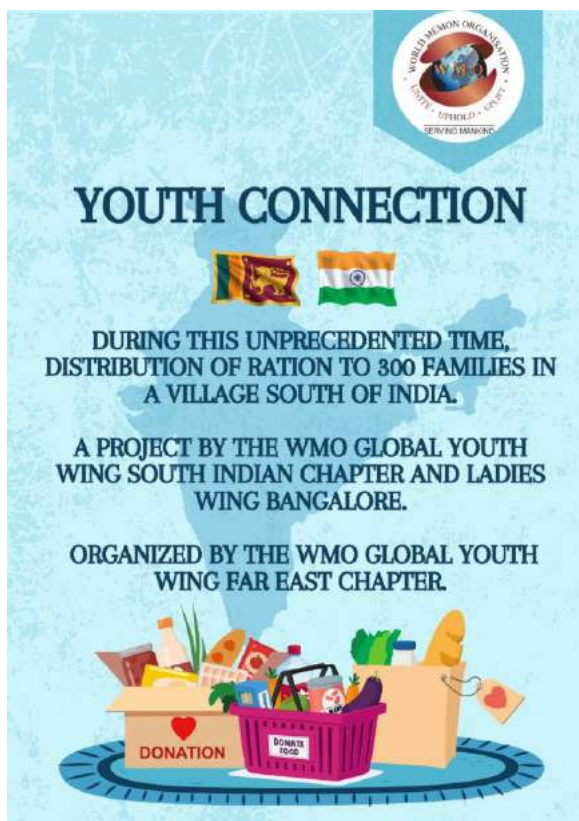
During these trying times, India is going through a tragic time. SOS is going through all social media requests for several things.
