WMO AFRICA CHAPTER MYCUP PROJECT

WMO AFRICA CHAPTER partnered with MyCup team continues to reach out to young South African women, donating and educating them on the benefits of silicone menstrual cups.

This project has become one close to the hearts of our members and donors especially our Project Coordinator; Dr Taheera Hassim. Our VP, Mr Feizul Ayob has become passionate about this project, and has constantly made funds available for this project! Dr Taheera Hassim's dedication is evident as she travels to various regions and visits numerous institutes, with the sole purpose of empowering these girls.

Our last campaign took place on Friday, 13 August 2021. Our first stop was at Potchefstroom Secondary School where 120 females students attended the workshop by Dr Taheera Hassim and Mycup Coordinator, Cara discussing Menstruation & Female Reproductive topics. A complete 3-hour session with the assistance of educator, *Mrs Hoorne* went off smoothly and was a huge success.

Thereafter, we visited a home 45 minutes away from Potchefstroom in Welverdiend, housing 60 young ladies. This home is managed by our partner; the Potch Muslim Women's Forum - Hajera Sooliman and team who donated hygiene packs, whilst WMO donated the silicone menstrual cups. Taheera addressed the older girls in a session, where she taught them to to use the cup during their menses. The residents were very appreciative of the kind gesture and time spent with them.

This project continues to grow in leaps and bounds and we hope that in the near future, the youth of WMO will become actively involved in this project and help us to expand and reach more potential institutions in South Africa.*




"IF YOU GIVE THANKS, I WILL GIVE YOU MORE"

WIDOWS, ORPHANS & NEEDY MUSLIM FAMILIES WELFARE ASSISTANCE

A WMO Welfare Committte has been elected in 2021, headed by the Chairman, Mr Moosa Carrim.

This is an ongoing project where financial assistance is offered to families in need and the destitute, funded by Zakaat monies donated by our members.

An amount of +- R150 000 is allocated towards these cases on a monthly basis.

Strict policies and procedures has been put in place to assess the zakaat eligibility of existing recipients and new applicants.

A Maualaana has been employed to do home visits of each recipient and follow up visits if needed.

Applications are renewed annually and reviewed by the Welfare Committee at regular meetings.
