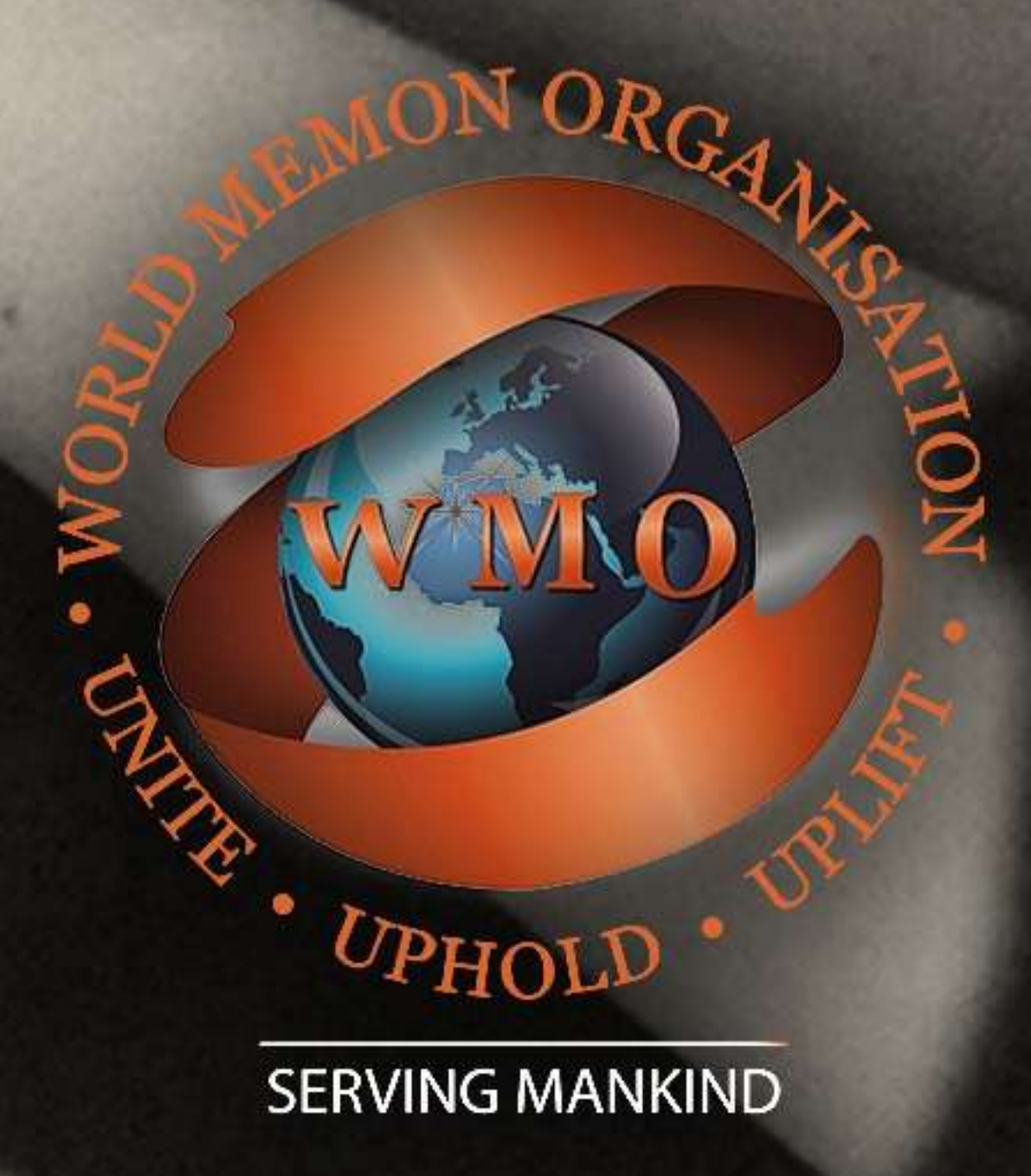

Late Mr.Usman Dalal (Haji bhai Lokhandwala):

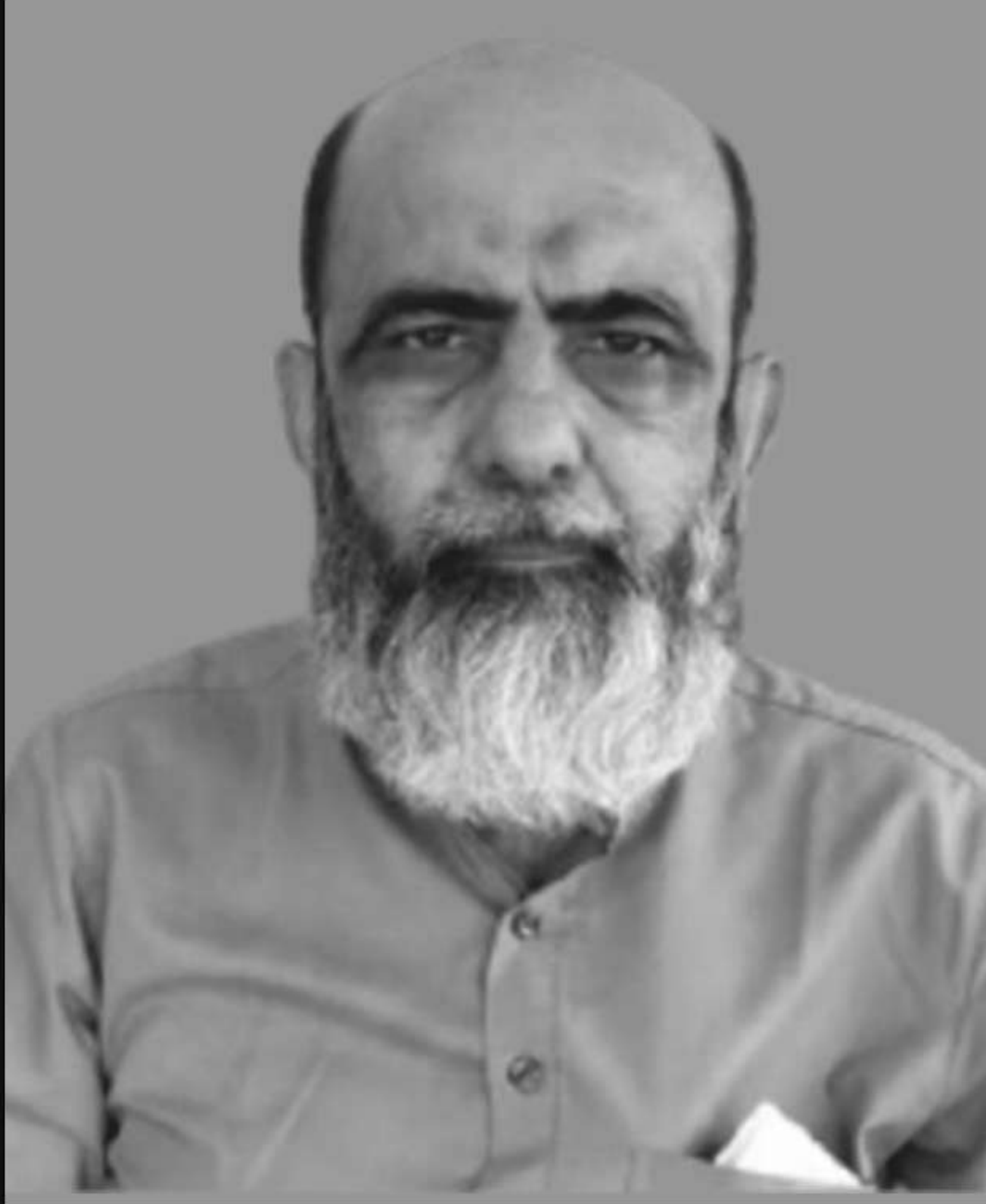

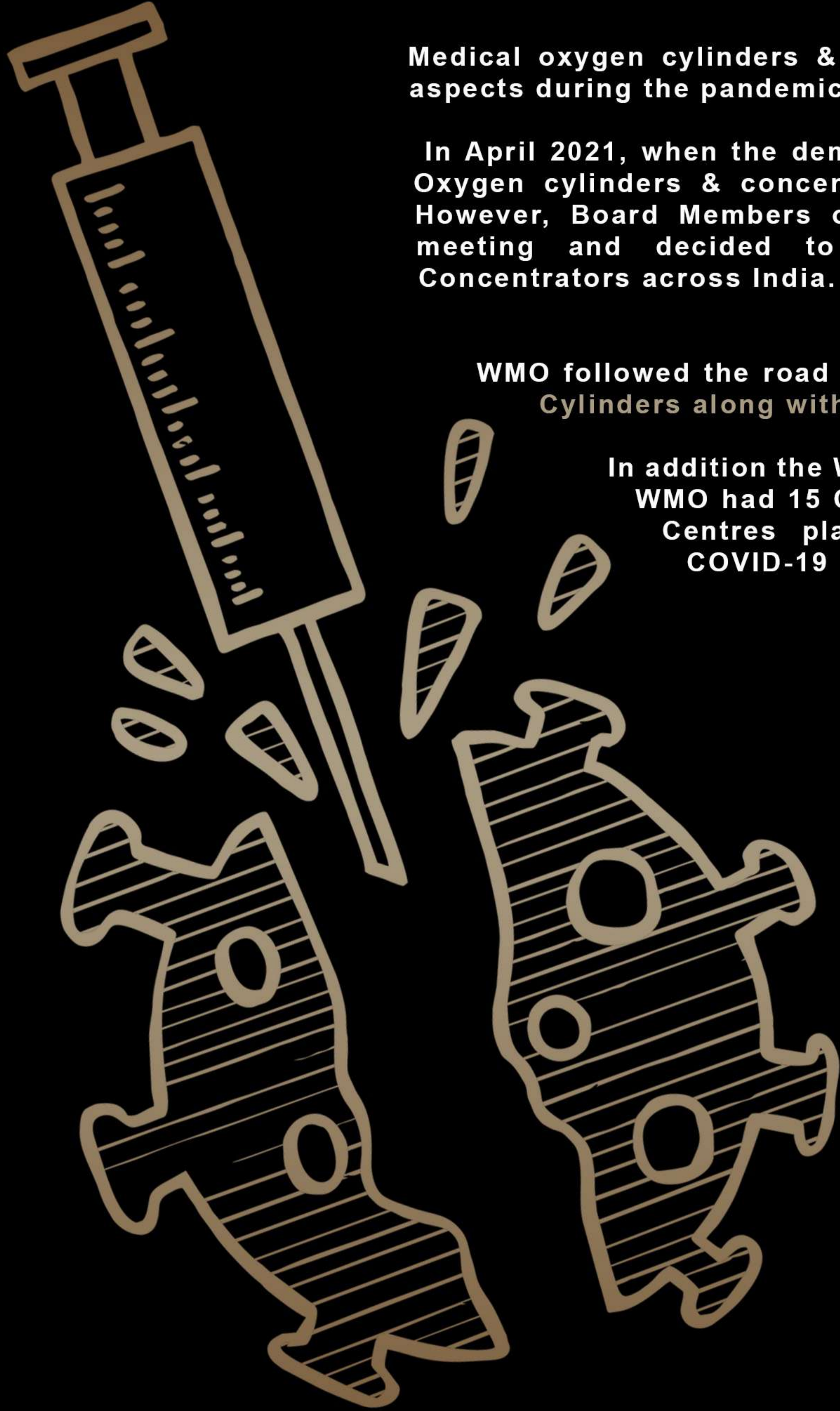
Oxygen Cylinders & COVID CARE CENTRES

WMO followed the road map of Covid Task Force, distributed approx, 2500 Cylinders along with its accessories & 1000 Oxygen Concentrators.

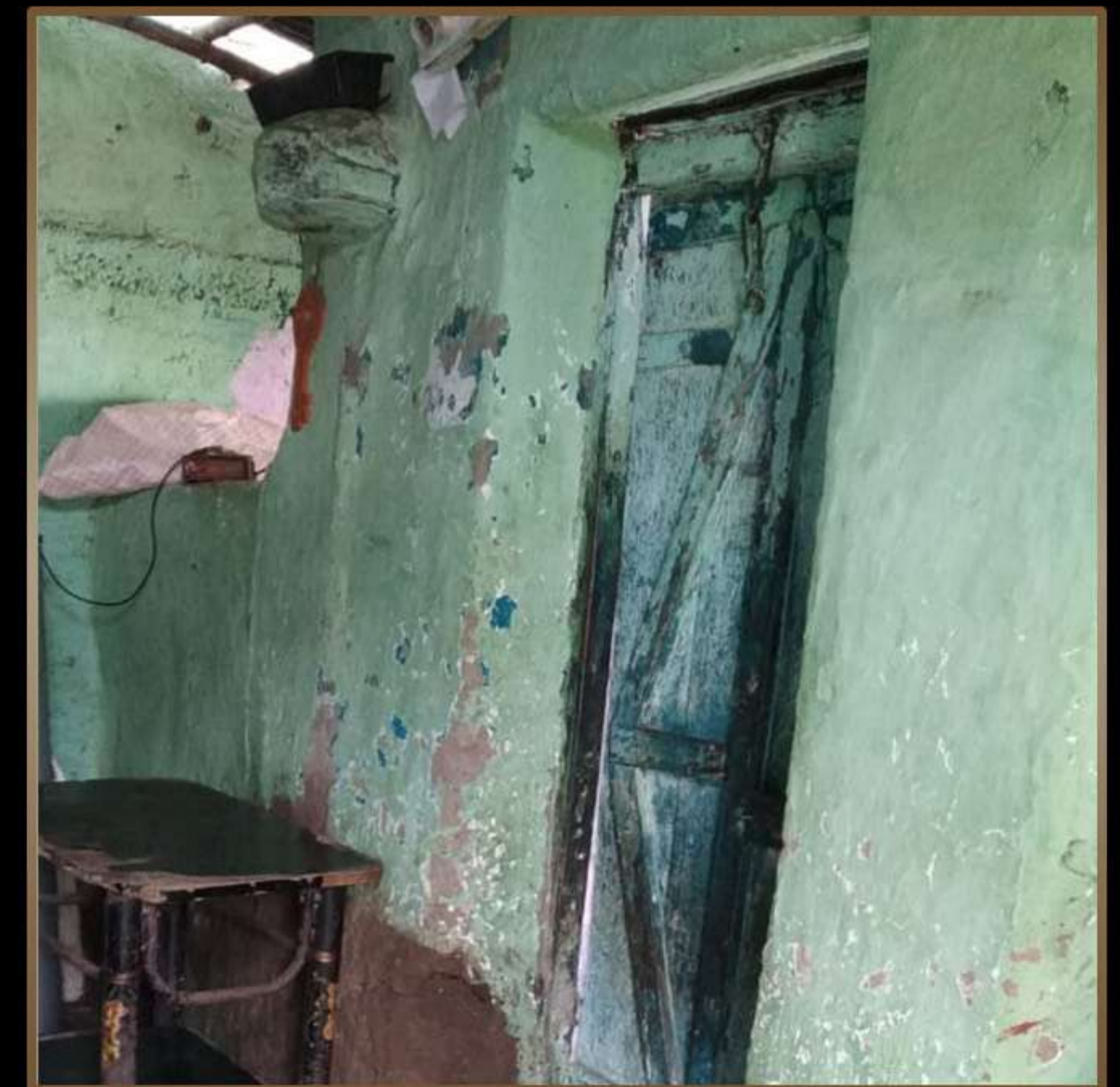

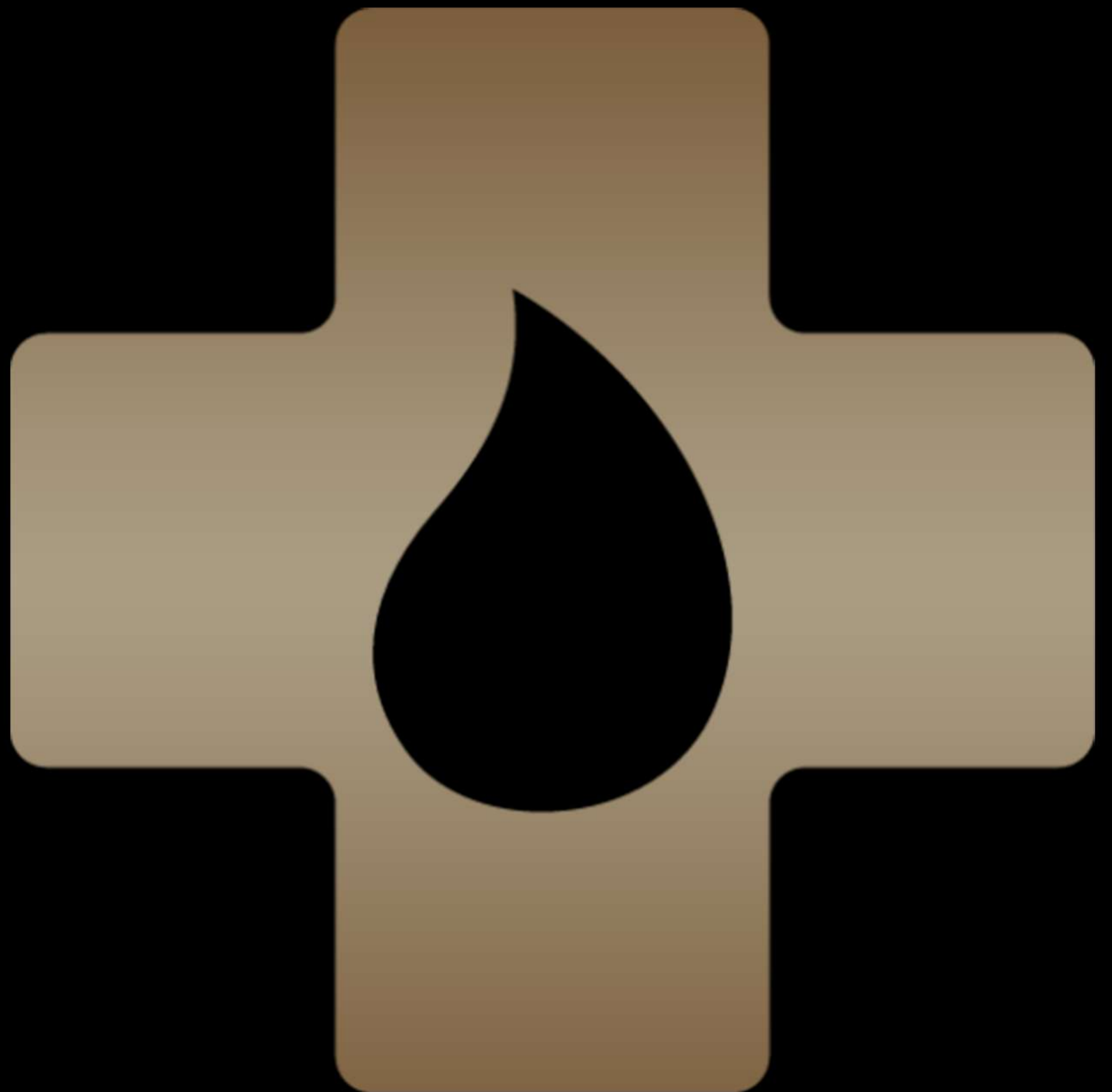

I was also conducted in Dhoraji, Gujarat successfully where more than 300 people were vaccinated for their first and second doses.

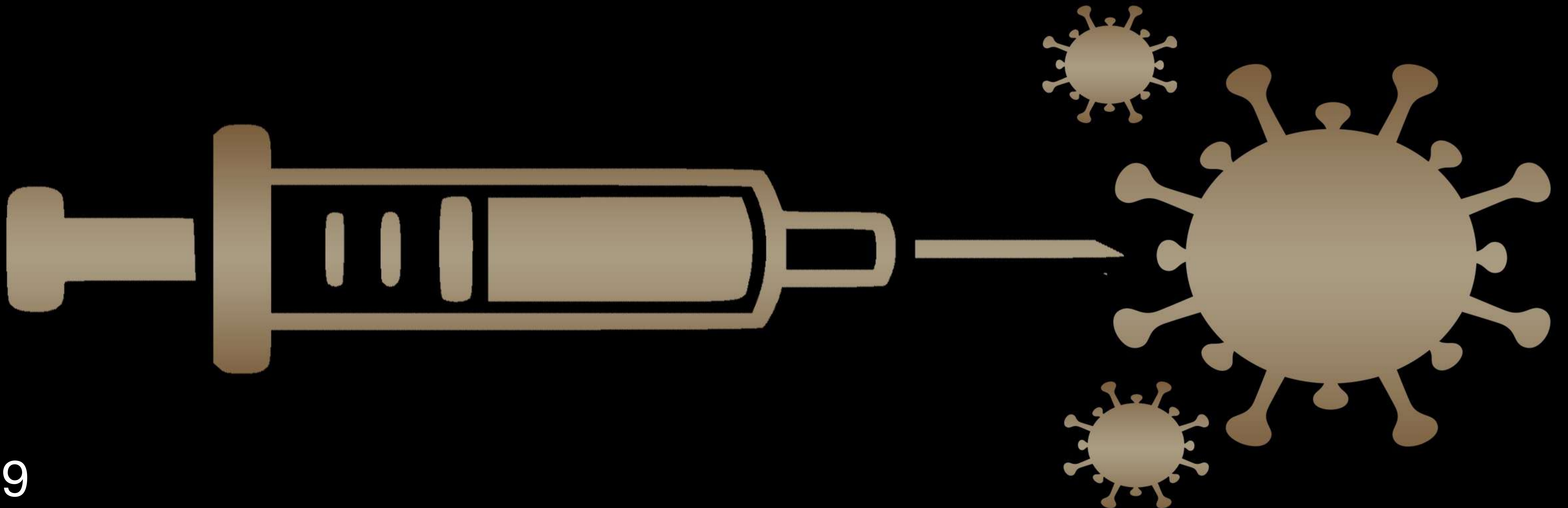

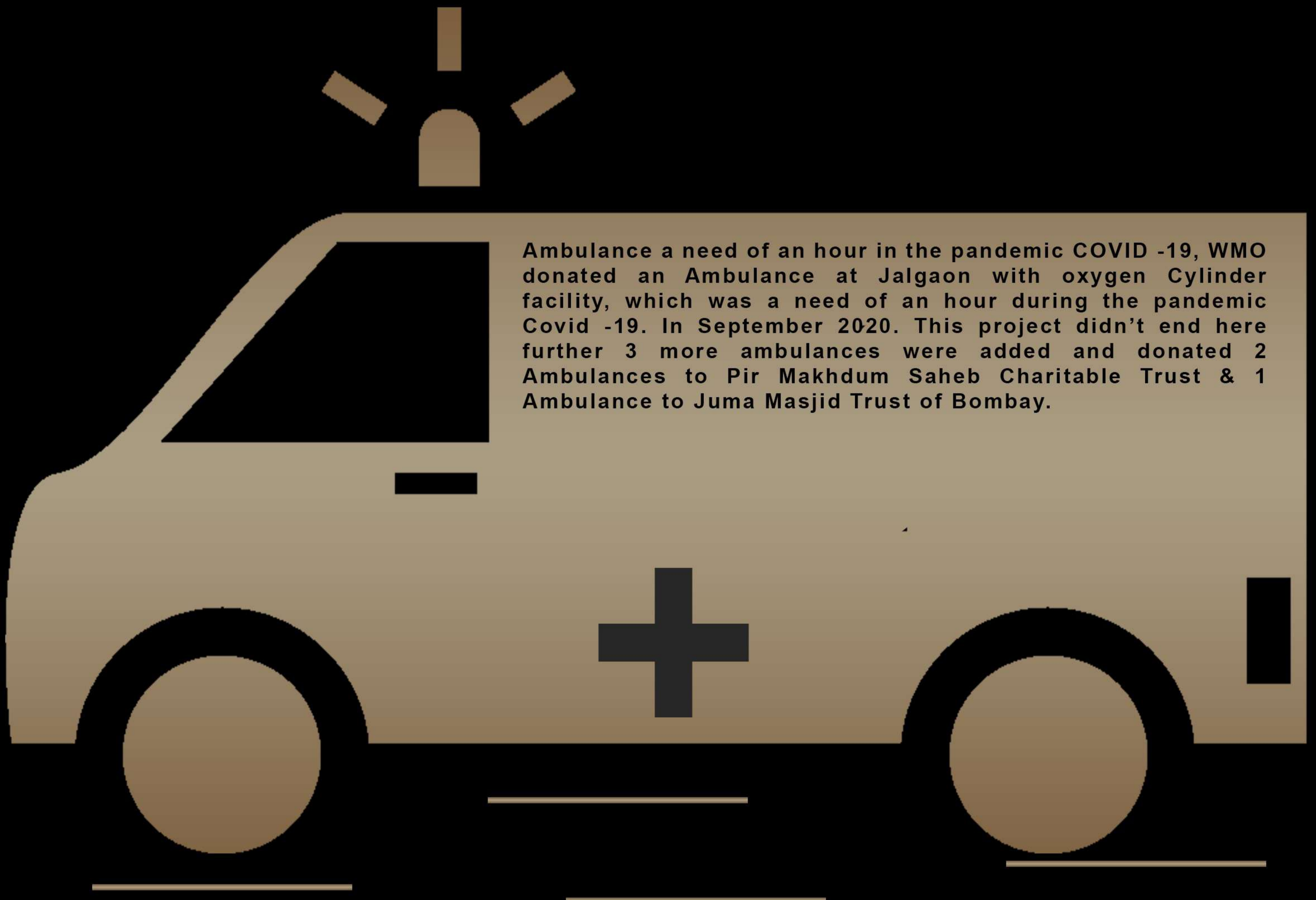
In this camp more than 1000+ patients were benefited with ECG, CBC and Hijama more were distributed for free of cost to patients with eye issues.

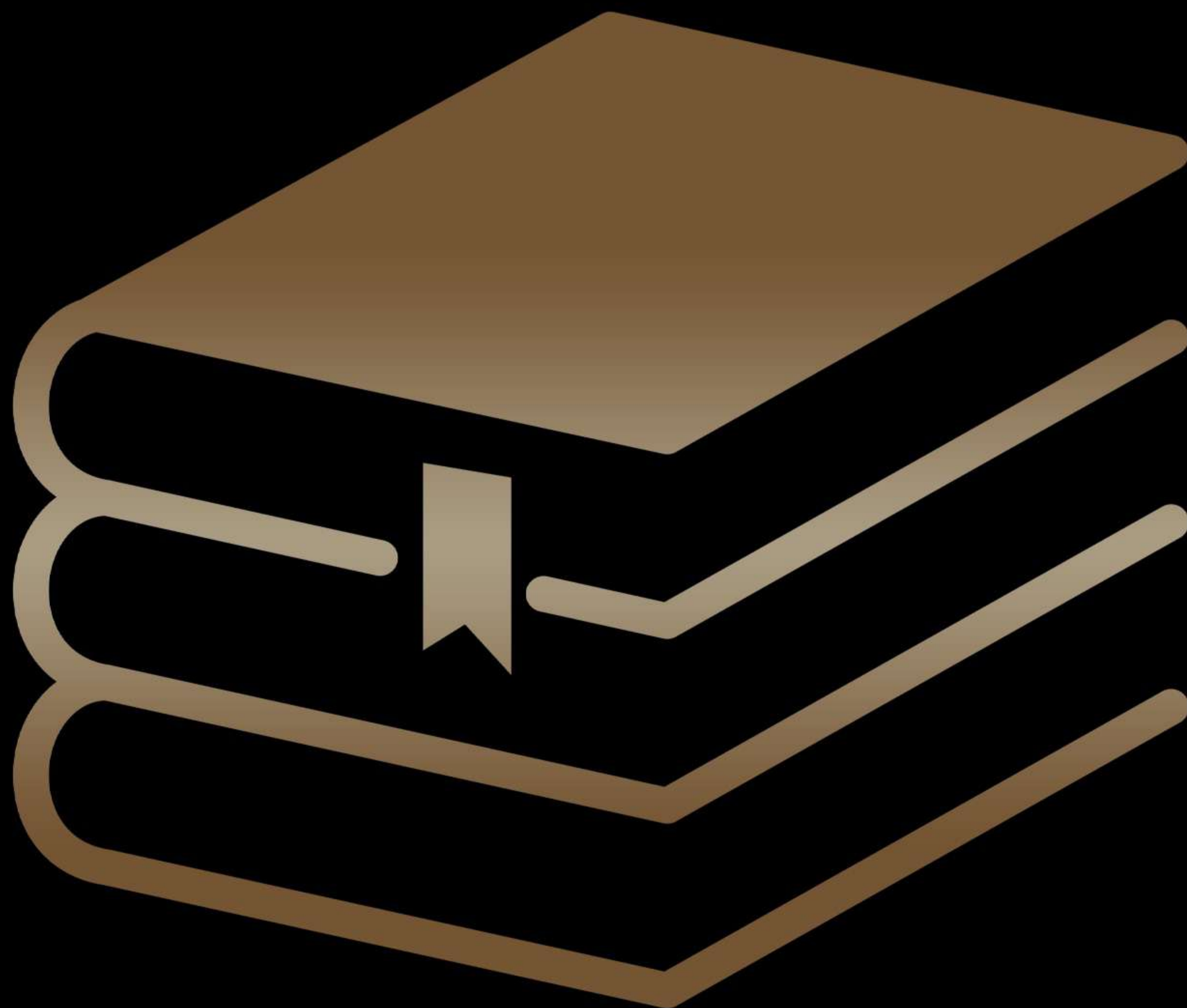

It is the dream project of World Memon Organization. 117 beds multi-specialty hospital is under construction at Village Shirgoan District Palghar. A village approx. 100 km from Mumbai towards Gujarat, while 7 km from Palghar railway station.

World Memon Organization in collaboration with Palghar Memon Welfare Trust (PMWT) initiated a dream project of providing charitable hospital in Palghar area. They are actively involved in humanitarian services in different parts of the world.

The story behind the huge project is lack of proper medical ambience and resources at and within 150 km's radius of Palghar. Almost 500 to 600 residents from our community come from that area. There are 100 to 120 small villages, and they have to travel 150 km for the treatment and that too the treatment is below the standards of a multi-specialty hospital.

This hospital will be structured in 2 phases, The Phase I will have 56 Beds, consisting 4 beds-emergency/ ICU, 17 beds - general beds for male, 19 beds -general beds for female, 5beds - AKD, 4 beds - NICU, 3 beds pre and post labor room and 4 beds single room.

SHEGOAN SCHOOL

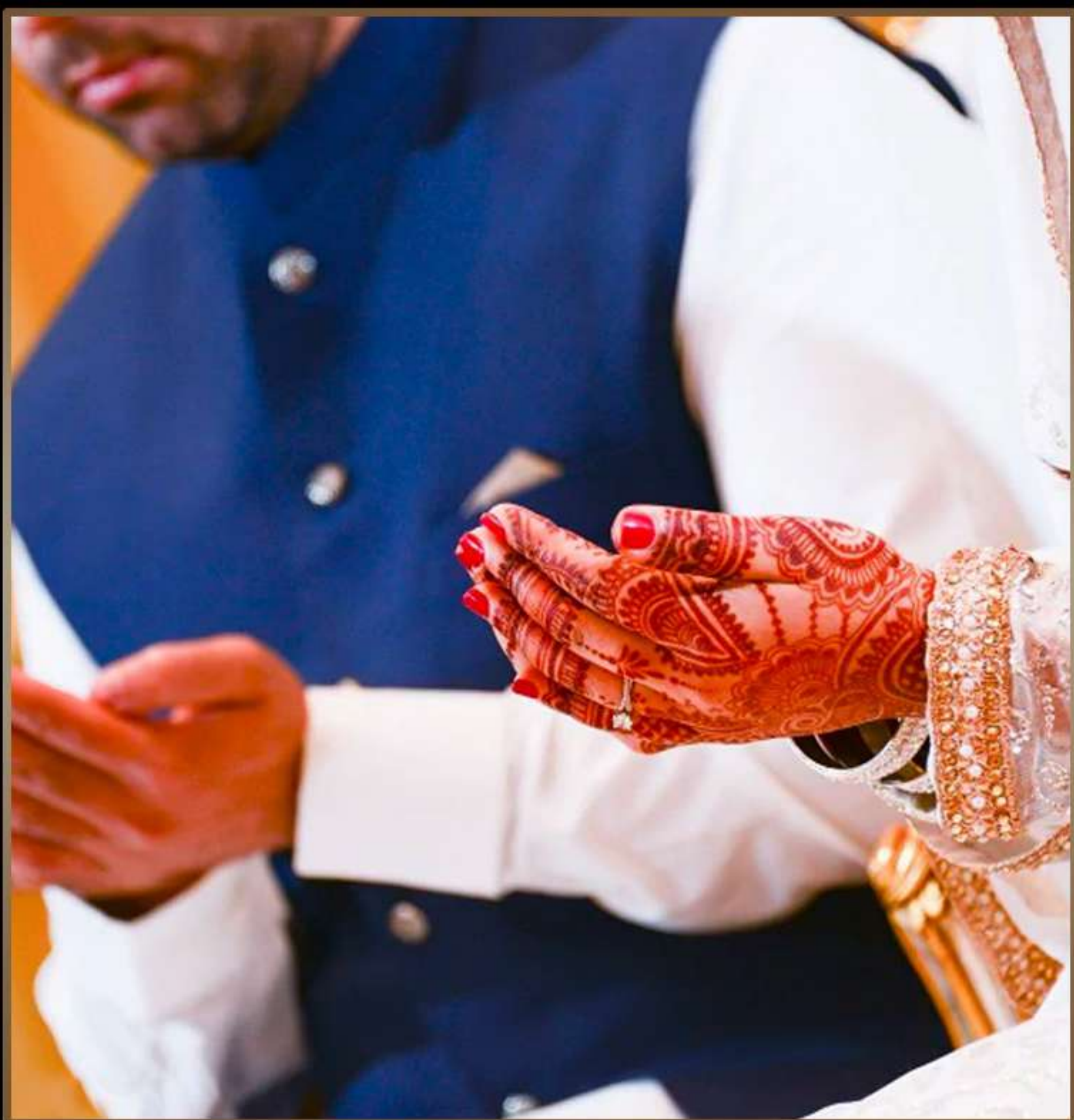
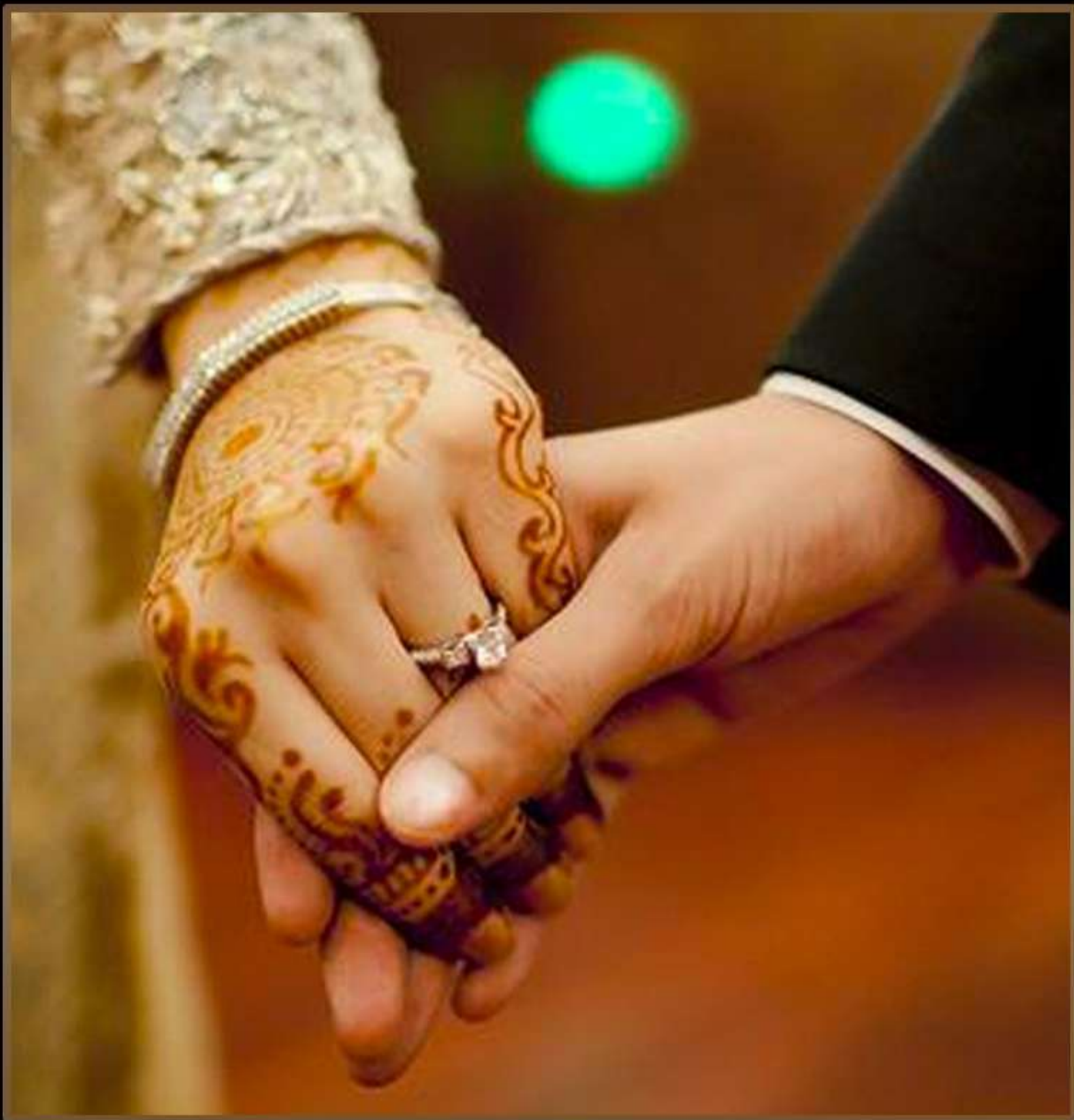
In 1905 the forefathers of Memon family in Shegaon envisioned an education institution for the community. To fulfil the pious mission Saleh Mohammad Jamal of Memon family purchased the Land in 1905. Later they founded the Anjuman school, and all the expenses of the school were borne by Alhaj Sattar Ibrahim Seth. The school kick-started from 5th standard in Masjid rooms which was served as a warehouse. But due to the lack of resources and inadequate educational ambience, they stopped the educational work in 1948.

But in 1958 young and devoted man Late Alhaj Abdul Sattar Ibrahim Seth Kacchi rolled his sleeves to impart education to the Memon community. The school was registered in 1958 through the charity commission under registration no F2 Buldana. Since the beginning all the expenses were funded by Memon Family and Alhaj Abdul Sattar Ibrahim Seth sb. Gradually it grew into a middle school. Teli Hospital was started in 2017 a charitable multispecialty hospital, – MANAGED BY M. M. SCHOOL TRUST – DHORAJI. The aim of the hospital is to serve the people of Dhoraji and surrounding talukas. The Hospital has the following departments; M.D Medicine Department, Orthopedic Department, Gynecologist Department, Pediatric Department, General surgeon, ENT department, Radiology Department etc. We have provided free Dialysis for 2 years and after that we are providing no cost dialysis service under Government Yojna - PMJY from 2019. We have advanced I.C.U with ventilators and BIPAP, Central Oxygen Line, Three advanced Operation Theaters, NICU with warmer, Ventilator, CPAP. Digital X-ray, C-Arm, Radiology Department with USG and ECCO and latest Pathology Lab. In September 2020 due to sudden rise in Covid cases, Teli Hospital Started Covid care Centre with Support of World Organization in which 48 Patients were treated in IPD and 450-500 patients in OPD. During this OPD and all the patients were provided free consultation and in IPD (Indoor case)

Further in the second wave from April 2021 to June 2021 approx 1800 patients were treated in OPD, and 180 patients were treated in IPD; free medicines and reports of needy and underprivileged patients in OPD. All this was possible with kind gesture and support of Teli hospital doctor panel which consists of; Doctor, Dr. Bhavin Patel (M.D. Physician) and his team Dr. Mayur Chaklasia, Dr. Darshak Goyani, Dr. Sanket Pokiya, Dr. Pravin Choudhry was always in standby mode and treated all patients and handled the ICU department very fluently. In addition during second wave of COVID Teli hospital had, tie up with specialist doctors who available on a call; s Dr. Shahib B. Garana (Critical Care Specialist), Dr. Savan Ghetia (Anesthetic and Critical Care) had also visited and consulted many patients at Teli Hospital. During this pandemic we specially thank our donor, World Memon Organization, who had donated Oxygen Cylinders, Cardiac Monitor, BIPAP and ICU Critical Care instrument.

All the work as stated above was served without any kind of discrimination of religion, cast creed and community. WMO is looking forward to help Teli Hospital with equipments they need. 2. Awareness Session of Covid-19: A workshop was organized by Raziabai Chasmawala (Co-Chairperson) of WMO Ladies Wing in collaboration with Maa Hoorbai Foundation regarding the awareness of Covid-19.

As people were not aware of Covid-19, awareness sessions were organized regarding the Information about Covid-19 virus, Mode of transmission of the virus, Safety Guidelines and Precaution from the virus. Along with all the information hygiene bags were also distributed which contains Face Mask, Wet Tissues & Sanitizer Bottles.

3. Mask Manufacturing Units: WMO Ladies wing started manufacturing Cloth Mask in their industrial home with the help of ladies. As this activity has helped many ladies earn money during the difficult period of lockdown.

4. Ration Distribution during Lockdown Ration Help was provided to a large number of beneficiaries during the period of lockdown in all the remote areas which helped them to survive during this pandemic time. More than 1500 ration kits were distributed in various areas of Akola, Aurangabad, Mumbai, and other cities.



5. Accommodation to Madarasa Students: Accommodation was provided to many students learning in Darul Uloom and Madrassa, as social distancing was not possible and there were high chances of spreading of virus.

6. Food Packet Distribution: More than 1000 Food packets were distributed to many laborers and migrant workers as they all were jobless and were not having proper food to eat.

7. Monsoon Drive: Monsoon Drive was organized at Maa Hoor Bai Community Hall, Mumbai where the ladies wing distributed Hygiene Pouches which included Hand Sanitizers and Masks. Raincoats and Umbrellas were also distributed as a part of monsoon drive.

8. Vocal for Local: After making our ladies learn, we are taking our community ladies on the paths of earning. With this project we have provided earning opportunities to the ladies of our community. We provided a Roti making machine to our Roti Bank Team to lessen their work.

9. Konkan Relief Fund: After Covid 19 Pandemic, Lockdown, Cyclone and Landslide, now Flood hit and affected Konkan villages in the worst way it could. Many people, mostly from Mahad and Chiplun were affected due to this flood. The height of the water was approximately 20 feet and more. Houses and Shops were all under water. People were running for their lives. However soon after this worst case scenario, WMO Ladies wing sent relief to Konkan villages and helped affected people by providing them basic needs like food, Medicines, clothes, sanitary pads, etc.

10. Beauty Webinar: Beauty Webinar was conducted on 6th September, 2020 by World Memon Organization which was organized by Ms. Nazia Pakizawala where the artist taught on how to do Bridal Makeup, Hairstyles, gave some Beauty Tips and Product Knowledge to the girls and women who joined the Webinar. The Webinar was absolutely free of cost and many girls and women joined the same.

11. International Women's Day: WMO Ladies wing celebrated International Women's Day by offering Tribute to Late Ms. Hamidabai Bhiwandiwala for her exemplary work in WMO since its Inception. They also started Tiffin Service and distributed packs of Chapattis and other food items to the poor and needy patients in the hospital.

12. Sapno Ki Udaan: The project has started in various cities across India where girls and women are benefitted by learning vocational courses such as Self Grooming, Fashion Designing, Baking and Decoration, Computer Course, etc.

13. Ramzan Help: WMO Ladies Wing initiated 400 food packet distribution everyday till the end Ramzan project where they distributed food packets every day during Ramzan for the poor and needy people. They also distributed ration kits, masks and hand sanitizers with a pamphlet which emphasized taking vaccines and distributed more than 3500 ration kits.

14. Roza Iftaari in Darul Uloom Madrassa: Children from Darul Uloom Madrassa were helped with a full month of Iftar in Ramzan considering they are orphans and besides this it was a countrywide lockdown which is the only month when they collect Zakath.

15. Distribution of Thermal Checkers and Oximeters to Doctors and Health Workers: WMO Ladies wing distributed Thermal Checkers and Oximeters to Doctors and Health Workers in local hospitals on 20-05-2021

16. Cyclone Tauktae: Ladies wing helped almost 350 families by handing over relief materials to them such as Tarpaulins and other necessary items. They also took a decision of helping 10 kids who lost their parents due to Covid or Cyclone of providing them food, education and shelter.

17. Home Health Care Oxygen Machines: Mrs. Raziabai Chashmawala provided Home Health Care Oxygen Machines to the needy people who were fighting with Covid 19 but wasn't able to get bed in hospitals and so was kept home isolated. This Oxygen machine helped many needy people during the time of pandemic.

18. Soap Making Webinar: On 3rd January, 2021, Ms. Nazia Pakizawala organized soap making webinar for the women of our community where Ms. Ghazia Sorathia taught to make Soap without using any machinery.

19. Rozedar ko Thandak: WMO Ladies Wing member Ms. Naziya Pakizawala organized "Rozedar ko Thandak" under the Ramadan Project of the World Memon Organization where she arranged and distributed Ration Kits and Air Coolers to the needy people of the community in Akola.

20. Health is Wealth Webinar: WMO also conducted "Health is Wealth" Webinar on 23rd January 2021 under the leadership of Ms. Naziya Pakizawala where the speaker Ms. Rukhsar S Mirza (M. Sc Biochemistry) made aware about why eating healthy is important. She spoke about Importance of Health, What to Eat/to avoid, Eating Habits, Portion Control, Calorie Count, etc.

21. Fun & Fair: WMO Ladies wing conducted a Fun & Fair event which was organized by Mrs. Maseela Naviwala where women were given free stalls to showcase their talent by selling whatever they are good at at home. Some of the women set up a stall of Pani Puri and some of Chocolates which they sold to the people present in the event so that they could earn some money from the same.

22. Muharram Project: Ms. Naziya Pakizawala organized this event on the occasion of Muharram where she distributed Sharbat, Biscuits, Rusk, etc to the poor and needy people in Akola.

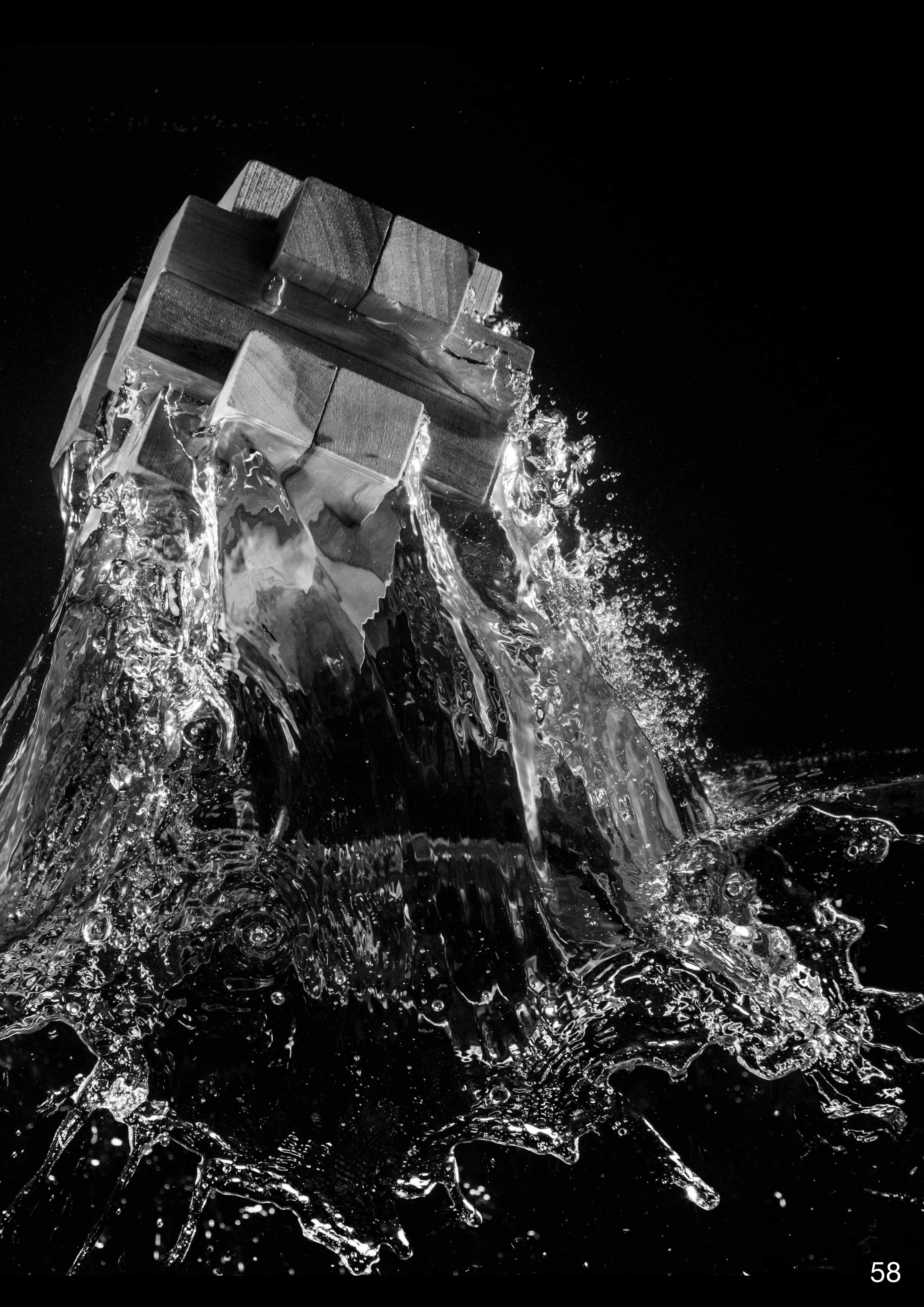

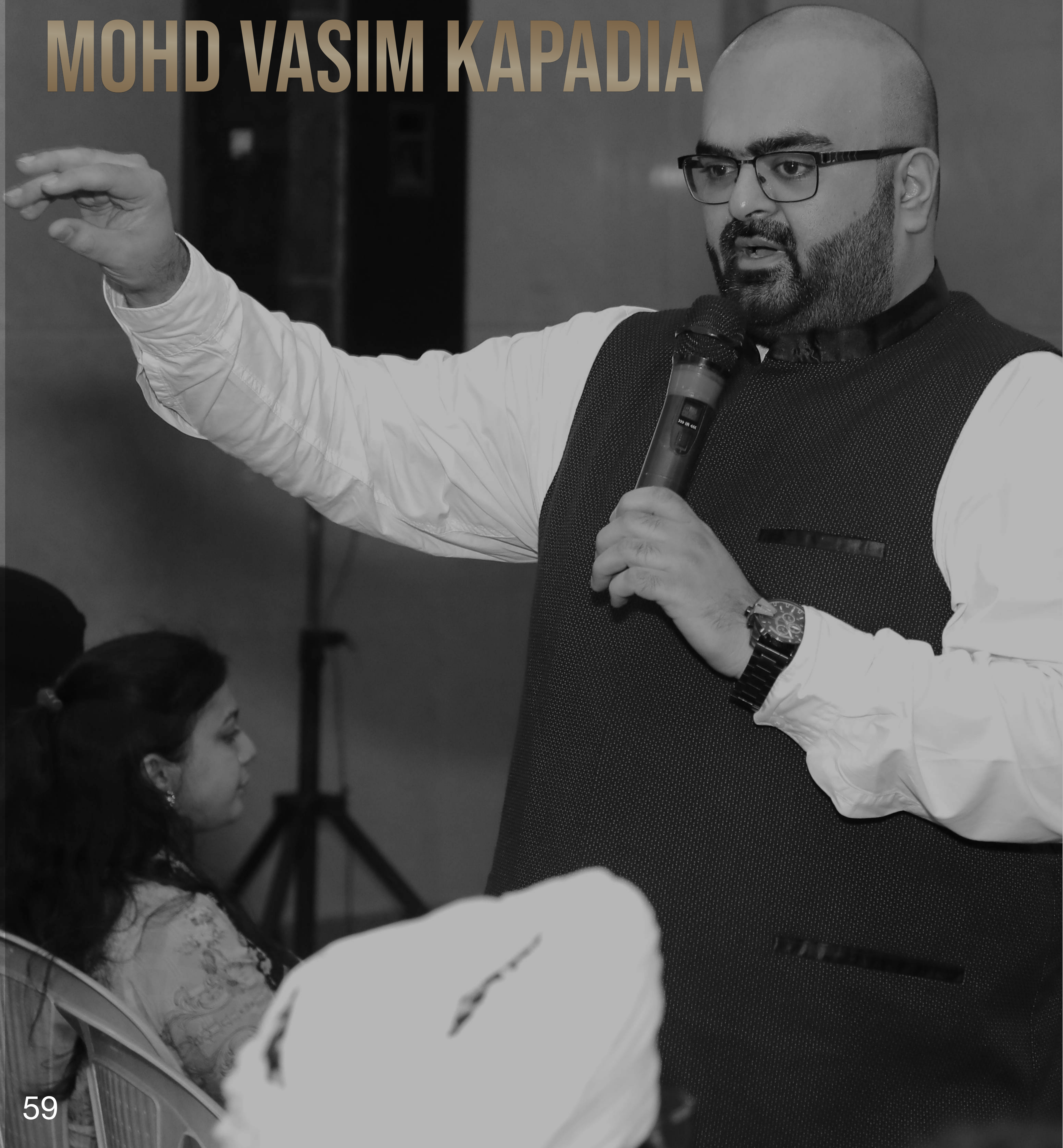

I was too, discovered in this event. I was given a free hand to bring a change in the current mindset of the youth in a way I wanted, and this gave rise to a unique concept called Memon Panchayat. In the Youth Parliament, we found leaders, but we still had to go deep in the interiors connect with the youth. Memon Panchayat came to our rescue. For the first time in Memon History, more than 71 Jamaats came together and conducted panchayats in their respected cities. After a long time, the Memon youth roared!!! We came to know what our youth wants and that gave rise to many new initiatives like Memon Startup Fund and Memon Investment Forum to boost the spirit of Entrepreneurship in the youth and on the other hand, initiatives like Project Mohabbat focused on community service and spreading love and harmony.

The youth now started getting active and participation increased. We even had a one of its kind knowledge exchange forum with the Jain community which was focused on boosting entrepreneurship in our community. Memon youth from all over India became a part of it and it was a highly productive session.

Very soon, Youth and Sports Development team was established in India and the recruitment drive for the RYE's lead to an increase of curiosity amongst the youth which resulted in a huge number applicants which was unexpected. One more change was brought in order to target the youth and that was, Change in style of communication. For a long time, the youth were expected to come to the forefront and become a part of our initiatives. Well, we changed the entire approach!!!

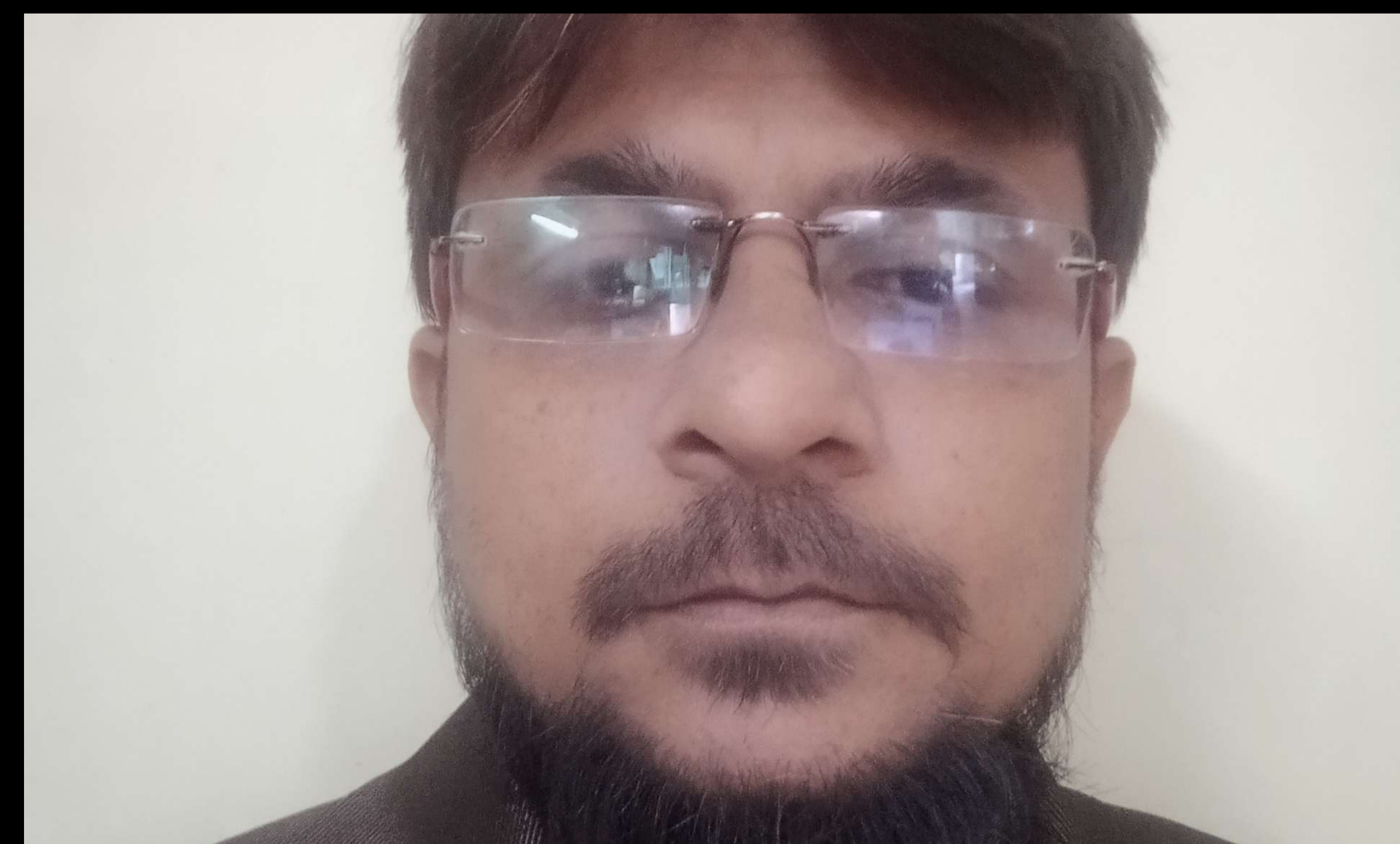

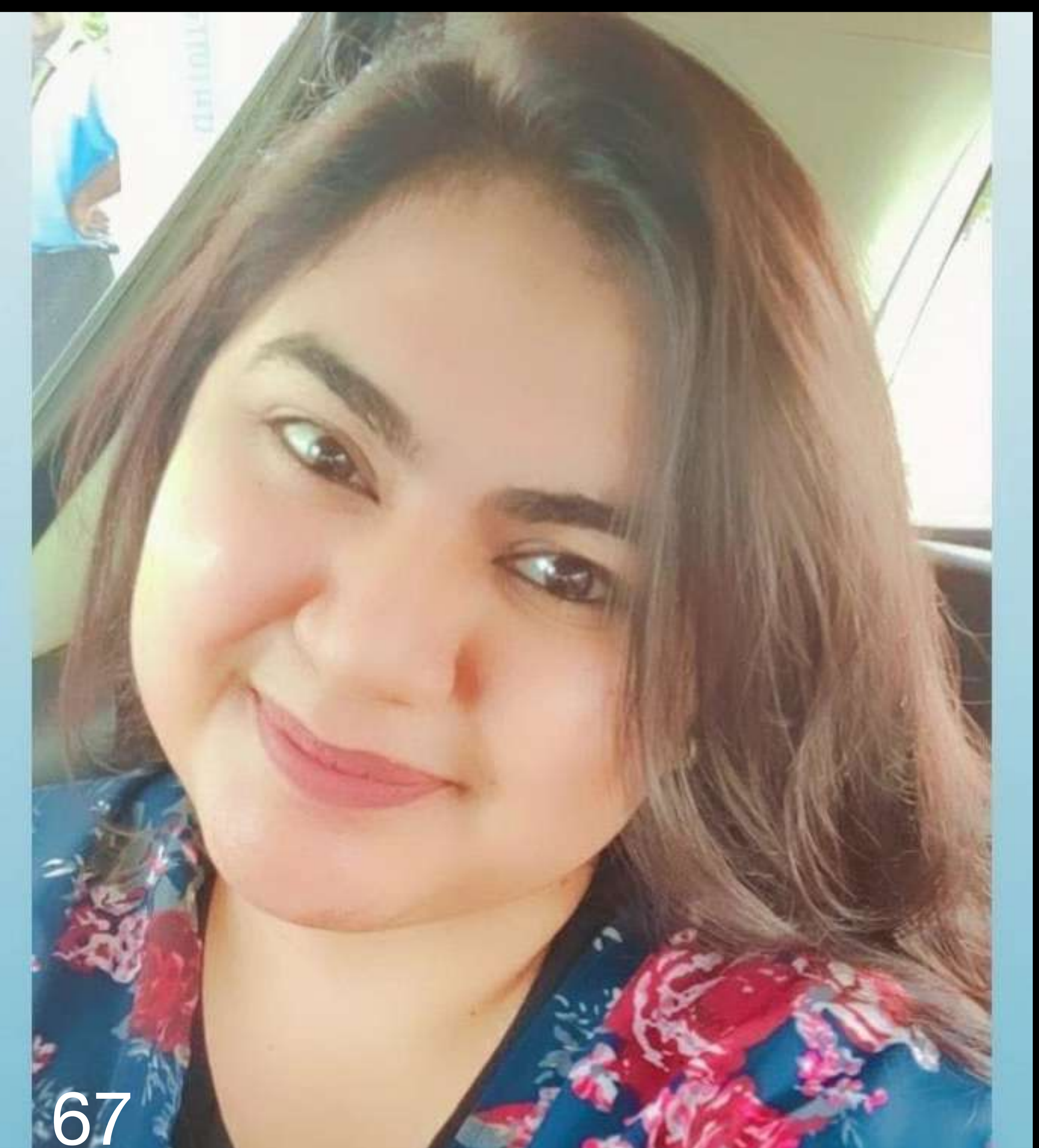

Why Mammogram and Pap Smear Camp?

To bring feminine medical awareness in our MEMOM COMMUNITY, especially in small cities like Bhavnagar where women tend to neglect tumors, and regret later.

Rotary club Bhavnagar owns a mammogram van and conducts camps annually in the Bhavnagar district.

Knowing the ill outcomes of breast cancer in the community Seema Virani Kholiya, in association with WMO YOUTH WING, Vasim Kapadia(President GYW), Mr. Ehsan Gadawala(President North India chapter), Late Mr. Javed Daula(RMC director) and Mr. Razzak Ghayal(Life member and trustee at HIM Zakariya) initiated the camp under the banner of youth wing WMO. And Mrs. Avika Agarwal (President of INNERWHEEL, Bhavnagar).

We borrowed the van from the Rotary club for 2 days camp, which was a roaring success in the district under the guidance of onco-surgeon Mr. Umang Desai, Mr. Viral Vadiya. And catered to around 100 women for mammogram and 30 women for pap smear test at Bhavnagar public school with suspected tumors and history of tumors.

What is a Mammogram and Pap Smear Test?

Mammogram is a tool to detect breast cancer.

Pap Smear is a cervical screening to detect cancerous cells.

Spreading Awareness:

To bring awareness into the Memon community we at YOUTH WING, WMO, Bhavnagar conducted a seminar on breast cancer detection.

AS onco-surgeon Dr Umang Desai said it's incredibly important as early detection, often through screening, can stop the disease when most treatable.

Again, cancer survival becomes more difficult n higher stages so awareness leading to a screening camp was crucial in Bhavnagar.

According to the report of Times of India in the 2020, one woman gets diagnosed with the breast cancer every 4 minutes in India.

The awareness program at rotary club Bhavnagar garnered almost 200 women curious to understand the simple explanation by the medical team.

The Result:

Three women out of almost 130 were suspected of the malignancy, wherein they were taken care by the doctor for free consultancy in aid from GLOBAL YOUTH WING, Bhavnagar, and family.

Also, it helped us create a medically educate community however to a small extent, but it was a first step into creating a medically educated MEMON COMMUNITY.
