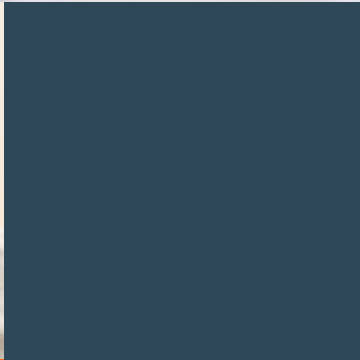
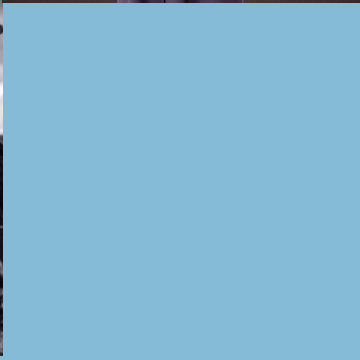

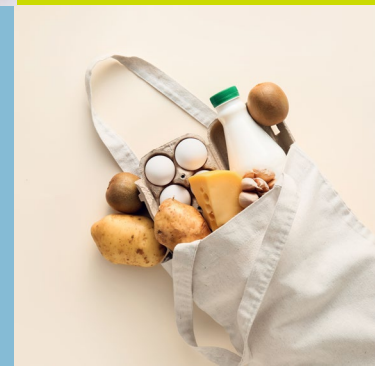
Approximately **75 million US dollars** have been donated towards humanitarian causes which have made a difference in the lives of an estimated 1.2 million recipients.

The organisation works towards the alleviation of poverty in the Memon community by providing homes to our less fortunate brothers and sisters.

Two wings of the WMO Ashiyaana Housing Project welcomed 30 families into their fold. The top brass of WMO North India Chapter inaugurated the premises and handed over the keys to the deserving families of Gadhada.



In the year 2008, a housing project consisting of 24 apartments was delivered to the deserving Memon families of Colombo, Sri Lanka. The project was built at Wennawatte in the Wellampitiya region of Colombo. WMO spent half a million dollars to complete the project in record time.

WMO has assisted 800 families to purchase their own homes in Pakistan and continues to provide rental assistance along with housing repairs.



Jasdan is a city located in the heart of Gujarat. August 8th, 2021 marks the foundation stone laying ceremony of another Ashiyaana housing project in India. WMO has taken another important step to fulfill the unrealized dreams of our forefathers who envisioned that every member of the Memon Community should have a roof over their head.



24th January 2021 marked the handover ceremony of Memon Tower at Manora, a town situated in the state of Maharashtra in Central India with a sizeable Memon population. The housing project which will be home to marginalised families of the Indian Memon Community.

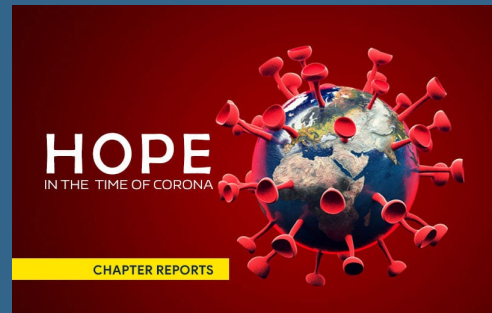
A 135 bed multi-speciality hospital is being built at Palghar, a city 90 kilometers north of Mumbai, enroute to Gujarat. The noteworthy USD 3.5 million dollar project is a collaboration between WMO North India Chapter and Palghar Memon Welfare Trust.



The World Memon Organisation Africa Chapter continues delivering wheelchairs to the aged, infirm and children with special needs. The wheelchair project has been a noteworthy endeavour of Africa Chapter for over a decade.



WMO has partnered with the Hashmanis Medical & Welfare Foundation and Ibrahim Hospital to perform free Corneal Transplant surgeries on the visually impaired in Pakistan. 135 successful surgeries have been performed thus far. Over the years, hundreds of auto rickshaws and thousands of sewing machines have been distributed to deserving families, under the Rozgar Scheme. For over a decade, the Rozgar Scheme has been achieving its objective of enabling the recipients to earn a livelihood, sustain their families, provide their children with an education thus ensuring a life with dignity.



The Micro Finance Program to enable the deserving to stand on their feet was initiated in 2013 by the WMO Far East Chapter to support small businesses and upcoming entrepreneurs. The program has since been emulated by other chapters across the globe. A sizeable number of Memons have benefitted immensely through Micro Financing since its inception.



15 underprivileged women working out of a tiny room in the far flung suburbs of Mumbai have established a Roti Bank Project. The Roti Making machine has enabled them to make hundreds of Rotis in a short span of time. Tiffin services, deliveries to restaurants and homes, more importantly the Rotis are being sent to hospitals to feed the ailing patients.



The Ladies wing of WMO North India Chapter have initiated another important endeavour to empower women in India with an aptly titled project – Sapno ki Udaan which literally translates into “giving wings to your dreams”. Empowerment of women belonging to the marginalised sections of society has been one of the most essential humanitarian services provided by WMO over the years.

Humanitarian Aid

WMO has always answered the call of the unfortunate victims of a human tragedy or a natural calamity in any part of the World. The organisation has been on the forefront and has contributed in every possible way to alleviate the pain and misery of those who seek refuge under these tragic circumstances.



World Memon Organisation mobilized funds to assist the Rohingya Muslims who fled to Bangladesh to survive the genocide in Myanmar. WMO stood firm, shoulder to shoulder with the Rohingya community during these uncertain times. WMO Africa Chapter handed over a cheque of 1.23 million Rands to the "Gift of the Givers" towards the victims of the recent earthquake and tsunami that struck the Island of Sulawesi in Indonesia.



WMO Africa Chapter has partnered with several local and international organisations to provide relief aid to the innocent victims of the devastating cyclone that ravaged Malawi in late January.
