



WMO ME set the benchmark where students should have a good education & attendance record, simultaneously making sure its real needy person in co-ordination with different Memon Jamats.


It is our firm belief that Education is the most Powerful Weapon which you can use to change the World hence we remain indebted to our donors for supporting this pertinent cause.

# Distribution of Woolens in Karachi, Pakistan.




WMO ME Chapter & Pakistan Chapter in joined efforts distributed Woolens

A memorable event was organized by the WMO ladies wing Middle East Chapter on the occasion of Women's day, at the Pakistan Association Dubai auditorium.




