Regional Secretary Message

The year 2024 has been a year of hard work, accountability, and progress for the World Memon Organisation – Pakistan Chapter (WMOPC). Our Secretariat worked hand in hand with Regional Management Committees, donors, partners, and volunteers to ensure that every initiative was carried out with transparency, efficiency, and measurable results. Each program we delivered this year was designed to meet urgent community needs while laying the foundation for sustainable development.

Key Highlights of 2024

- **Education – A 33% Budget Increase:** Education remained our foremost priority. This year, we increased our education budget by nearly one-third, enabling us to expand both higher and lower education sponsorships. The Memon Education Monetary Fund was further strengthened, ensuring that quality education is accessible to students across Pakistan. The policy framework of MEMF finalized to start contributing to the community
- **Healthcare Expansion:** The distribution of Health card started in this year to ease out the health financial cost of the members of the community. We also funded critical treatments such as surgeries and therapies for special children, ensuring no member of our community was neglected.
- **Community Welfare:** Traditional welfare programs including Mahana Madad for deserving families, Ramadan ration distribution, and other emergency support programs to ensure sustainability.
- **Empowerment through MITI:** The Memon Industrial & Technical Institute (MITI) remained a cornerstone of empowerment. By introducing new courses & collaborations with industries, MITI continued to equip young minds with practical skills for employability and long-term livelihoods.
- **Flood Relief and Rehabilitation:** Following the devastating floods of earlier years, our rehabilitation program remained in full swing in 2024. All our targeted areas got completed in this year and we managed to complete almost 1000 houses in Sindh.

As we step into 2025, the Secretariat is committed to further strengthening Education and Health, while also ensuring that welfare and rehabilitation projects continue to reach the most vulnerable.

REGIONAL ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF WMOPC

The Regional Annual General Meeting (RAGM) WMO Pakistan Chapter was held on Friday, 12th July 2024 at 6:30 pm at Karachi Gymkhana, Karachi. The meeting was attended by more than 100 participants, including Office Bearers, Trustees, Patrons, Life Members, Apex Bodies, Youth and Ladies Wing representatives, Jamaal, and Guests.

The meeting began with Recitation from the Holy Quran followed by the National Anthem. Documentary and presentations highlighted the achievements of WMOPC during the year 2023.

The Minutes of the last AMM were unanimously approved. Mr. Musaab Mansoor Vindhani, Regional Treasurer, presented the Audited Accounts for the year ending 31st December 2023, reporting collections of Rs. 360m Zakat & disbursements across multiple projects, which were approved by the house. Appointment of Auditors for 2024 was also confirmed.

During 2023, WMOPC carried forward its mission with major projects:

- Education: Supported 7,500 students with Rs. 200m, 250 higher education students with Rs. 20m. Launched Memon Education Monetary Foundation (MEMF) in collaboration with APMF, MPF, and MEB.
- Health: 280 cornea transplants, 275 special children supported, and 10,000 Health Cards initiative launched.
- Rehabilitation & Relief: 32 housing cases and 40 rental supports covered; 600+ flood relief houses delivered, 400 under construction.
- Welfare: Daily Food Bank serving 1,000 meals, Mahana Madad for 500 families, Qurbani distribution for 3,200 families.
- Youth & Ladies Wing: Organized events and welfare activities worth Rs. 8m collectively.

The meeting concluded with Vote of Thanks by Mr. Arsalan Arif Nara, Regional Secretary, followed by Dua-

HEALTH CARE PROJECT

(REYAZ AHMED)

Gift Of Sight

WMOPC started project of Gift of Sight few years ago with support from Far East Chapter of WMO. We were getting Eye Corneas from Sri Lanka and transplants were performed at two local hospitals in Karachi. We have done more than 200 Corneal Transplants were done. WMOPC was bearing all the local expenses of these surgeries including clearance of Corneas at the Airport.

Due to Covid, this project was almost stopped for a long time. We then had issues in getting corneas from Sri Lanka. Soon after another community hospital, Memon Medical Institute started Free corneal transplants so to avoid duplication, we stopped this project and started giving our full attention to Special Needs Children Project which was already in progress by WMOPC.

We are now going to start Eye Retina Surgeries for poor patients of Memon Community Alhamdulillah**

Empowering Through Inclusion (Special Children) Project

Since its inception in 2019, the Special Needs Children Project (SNCP) of World Memon Organisation Pakistan Chapter (WMOPC) has been serving children with developmental, neurological, and physical challenges.

The project currently supports 267 registered special needs children (SNC), providing them with a range of essential medical, therapeutic, educational, and vocational services

Medical Support

1. Neurology Consultations

* We maintain a weekly quota of 5 children at Liaquat National Hospital under the care of *Dr. Raman Kumar* (Pediatric Neurologist). This has enabled more than 200 followup visits in a year.

* For adult neurology cases, we refer patients to Dr. Shazia Jatoi* at Jamal Noor Hospital, handling approximately 100 cases annually.

2. Need-Based Specialist Consultations

We also facilitate referrals to various specialists on a case-by-case basis, including:

- Dr. Mukhtar Singapori (ENT) – Jamal Noor Hospital
- Dr. Kamran Younus (Pediatric Cardiologist) – Aga Khan University Hospital
- Various departments – Memon Medical Institute Hospital (MMIH)

We are now planning to initiate a monthly follow-up clinic with Dr. Sana Ashraf (Pediatric Neurologist) at WMO House.

3. Medication

Currently, 120 children are receiving neuro & related medications monthly, as prescribed by our panel of doctors.



4. Diagnostics (Lab & Imaging)

Lab tests and imaging are conducted mainly at MMIH. We require approximately two diagnostic procedures per month, including:

- * EEG
- * MRI
- * CT Scans
- * Blood tests

Rehabilitation & Therapy

1. Counseling for Parents

Our expert counselors provide regular sessions to parents**, guiding them in managing their children's conditions and expectations.

2. Therapy Services

- * Children receive regular physiotherapy and occupational therapy and at home.
- * As well, the children are getting various therapies in many rehabilitation centers.
- * Psychological support is provided on a need basis, and we are now initiating referrals to psychiatrists for mothers facing mental health challenges.

Education & Empowerment

1. Special Education

We support SNC by enrolling them in special education & rehabilitation centers, covering their monthly tuition fees.

2. Assistive Devices

We regularly provide body-supporting and mobility aids such as:

- * KFO, AFO, HKFO Jackets
- * Hearing Aids (typically replaced every 3 years)
- * Tailor made chairs
- * Others

These tools are essential for mobility, support, and communication, and often require replacement due to growth or wear and tear.

3. Vocational Training

We have initiated computer training for adult SNC and are proud that one of our trainees has successfully transitioned to office employment.

This holistic approach ensures that children with special needs receive medical, emotional, educational, & vocational support — enabling them and their families to lead more dignified and empowered lives.

This is a life change program. Many children are waiting for enrollment with WMOPC and additional supports.

A humble request to all for more & more support to this very important project of WMOPC.

Health Card

On 18th February 2024, the World Memon Organisation Pakistan Chapter, in collaboration with All Pakistan Memon Federation (APMF) and Takaful Bazaar, launched the first-ever Health Card for the Memon Community.

This groundbreaking scheme provides:

- Medical coverage up to PKR 500,000 annually
- Coverage for pre-existing conditions, accidents, emergencies, maternity care, & surgeries
- Financial protection so that no Memon is deprived of healthcare due to lack of resources

Through this initiative in 2024, WMO Pakistan Chapter has supported:

- Total amount spent: PKR 7,380,208
- We are proud to be partners with APMF in this milestone project, which is bringing health security and peace of mind to Memon families across Pakistan.

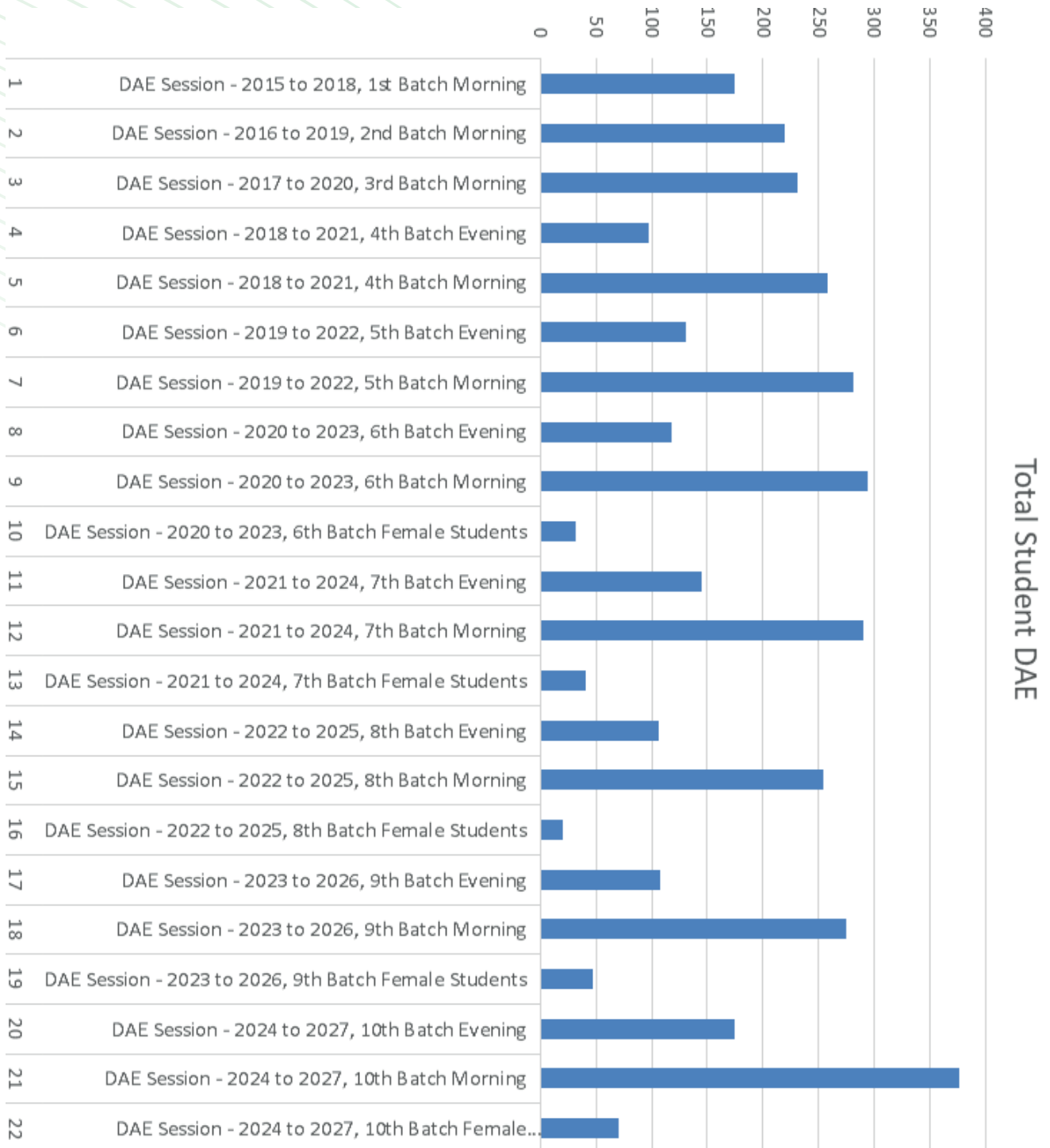

The Future

MITI prides itself in becoming a premier institution for vocational training in the country & the management and staff of MITI are committed in its continued growth to help the destitute people of society for upward mobility.

We are humbled by the achievements and are grateful to Allah SWT for guiding us in the right direction and giving success in our ventures.

Expansion and Renovation of Facilities

By the grace of Allah, MITI has completed 14 years of operation. In these 14 years, we have served more than 120,000 students. The graduating students have been well received by the industry locally as well as internationally which is due to hard work and commitment of the management and our faculty team. To achieve these objectives, our workshops and other facilities were purpose built to satisfy the training needs of the time.

The time has now come when we are faced with the necessity of the following:

- 1. Addition Of New Equipment:** Many of the equipment and facilities have become old while new ones have not been added. The present facilities are falling behind the requirements and advancements in industry.

Computer hardware is one big area which requires up gradation. Our computers are no longer compatible with the software that are now available and have become standards of the industry and which we are teaching. So far, we have been coping with these requirements by ad hoc up gradations but this has a limit. PKR 5,000,000 are required for upgrading all the computers in our classes.

- 2. New Courses:** To remain competitive, it is necessary to keep pace with the needs of the students and employers and introduce new courses from time to time. We have fallen behind in this important feature and introduce new courses very soon. We badly need to begin the following courses which are demands of the industry:

- Industrial Electronics
- Fashion Marketing & Merchandizing
- Renewable Energy
- Instrumentation
- Auto body Refinishing

- 3. Expansion of Facilities:**

- Besides the academic needs, there are needs of building and facilities.
- New class rooms/labs are required for the DAE section. PKR 6,000,000 are required.
- Our power bill is very high. The answer is in going for solar. This solution is most economical in the long run but initial investment is high. We have already installed solar generation of 62 KW but now require to increase to 100 KW. PKR 100,000 are required for this project
- The fiber glass roof is leaking badly and needs to be replaced. We also need a fully functional and well equipped Auditorium.

Your valuable contribution in this cause is the dire need of MITI which can rightly be called the flagship project of the World Memon Organization.

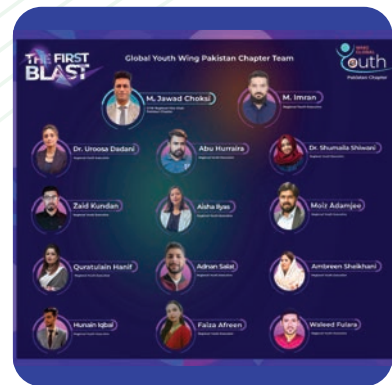
The Beginning of a New Era

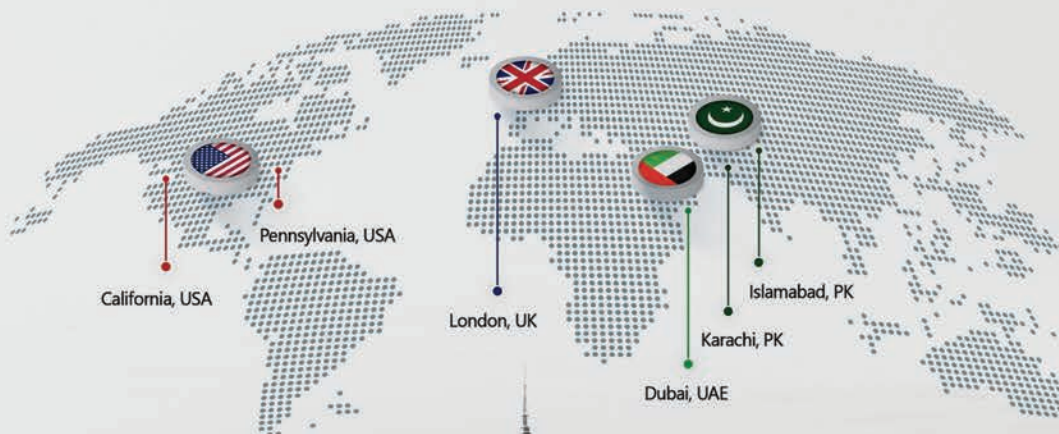

Since its inception in 2021, the initiative has grown into a sustainable welfare program providing monthly financial aid to 500 families, each receiving PKR 5,000 per month – totalling PKR 30 Million annually.

Implementation in 2024

- Support is disbursed transparently through banking channels in collaboration with respective Jamaats.
- Beneficiaries include widows, divorcees, and low-income households across Karachi, Hyderabad, Sukkur, and Thatta.
- Over 47 Jamaats are actively engaged in ensuring that financial assistance reaches the most deserving families.

FLOOD RELIEF PROGRAM

(ARSALAN NARA)

Introduction

The floods of 2022 were among the most devastating natural disasters in Pakistan's history, leaving thousands of families without shelter, food, & security. What began as an emergency relief mission by WMOPC has, by the grace of Almighty Allah & with the unwavering support of our donors & partners, now reached its successful conclusion in 2024. This report documents the completion of our three-year journey of relief, rehabilitation, and rebuilding.

Objective

Our objective throughout the program was not only to provide urgent relief but to restore dignity, stability, and hope to flood-affected families through sustainable rehabilitation.

Journey of Relief to Rehabilitation (2022–2024)

Immediate Relief (2022):

- Supported 6,000 families with ration bags, ready-to-eat meals, and water coolers.
- Provided medical care and hygiene support to prevent disease outbreaks.
- Temporary shelters set up for 200 families who had lost everything.

Transition to Rehabilitation (2022–2023):

- Constructed 100+ houses in Balochistan to provide permanent shelter.
- Initiated large-scale housing in Sindh; by end of 2023, over 600 houses were completed and 250 more under construction.

Completion & Achievements (2024):

- By the last quarter of 2024, WMOPC successfully completed over **1,000 permanent houses**.
- Integrated sanitation facilities with housing to ensure healthy living conditions.
- The total program expenditure reached PKR 280 million, making it one of the largest rehabilitation projects ever undertaken by WMOPC.

Challenges Overcome

- Logistical Barriers: Access to submerged areas delayed work.
- Funding Gaps: High inflation and increased costs required additional fundraising.
- Sustainability: Ensuring that new housing met community needs for long-term stability.

- Collections: PKR 273 million
 - 25% raised within Pakistan
 - 75% raised internationally
 - 60% contributed as Zakat
- Utilization: Over 90% disbursed on housing, logistics, food, and rehabilitation.

Conclusion

The Flood Program that began as an emergency mission in 2022 has successfully concluded in 2024 with the completion of more than 1,000 houses. This achievement reflects the compassion, unity, and generosity of our global Memon community. WMOPC takes pride in having restored homes, dignity, and hope for families who had lost everything.

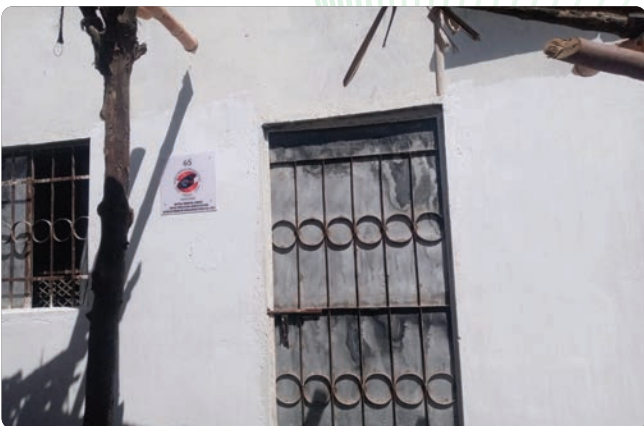

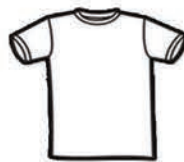
